



Connie May is a half-Chinese Canadian singer/ songwriter currently based in NY, who is well-known for her vibrant energy and show-stopping performances. Writing in the genre of pop, May's intimate originals bring her story to the stage. Connie is currently working on a series of new singles, co-written with Isabella Kearney and produced by David Spencer. Known for his work with Grammy-winning and chart-topping artists, David Spencer has over 200 million streams across his productions and has placed music on major platforms including *The Voice*, *Supergirl*, *Cloak and Dagger*, and the Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade.

Connie May's debut song came out in 2023, produced by Bølt and David "DQ" Quinones, a world-class hitmaker who has collaborated with legendary artists like Beyoncé, Brandy, BTS, Demi Lovato, Enrique Iglesias, Jason Derulo, JLo, Lil Wayne, Nicki Minaj, and The Pussycat Dolls. Hardworking and determined, May strives to create honest narratives. With her evocative and powerful vocals, she will take you on a journey you're not soon to forget. Although her personality revolves around being bubbly, in a professional setting, she is known to be headstrong and reliable. She takes influence from other artists such as Demi Lovato, Sabrina Carpenter, Ariana Grande, and Lianne La Havas. May has worked with Grammy award-winning industry professionals all around America. The beginning of 2023

kicked off a successful first tour alongside the East Coast of Canada. Her tour has opened up many opportunities, including other tour dates and festival slots in the upcoming year. Born and raised in Nova Scotia, Canada, May is now based in NYC.

Growing up, May started solo singing at the age of eight and got the opportunity to perform as a featured artist at many major events and multi-cultural festivals. In 2019, she won multiple first-place titles in the Kiwanis Music Festival, including Jazz and Junior Musical Theatre. She also represented Halifax in the Junior Musical Theatre category at the provincial competition and won first place in that as well. She continued her studies at the acclaimed Berklee College of Music, graduating in the spring of 2023 with a Bachelor of Music degree in songwriting and minoring in musical theatre performance.

Furthermore, at just 19 years old, May ran her own show at Halifax's Fringe Festival. The show was fully constructed of youth with disabilities and gave many the opportunity to perform for the first time ever. Taking place on Neptune Theatre's stage, the 2-day running show was a huge success.

May has studied voice under; Vera Savage; Zoey Leger; and Gabrielle Goodman, who has worked alongside names such as Chaka Khan, Al Jarreau, Nancy Wilson, and Roberta Flack. She has studied songwriting under Paula Gallitano, who has worked with LuLa Hathaway and Tina Turner. Moreover, Connie studied under Pat Pattison, who revolutionized the process of songwriting, taught the likes of John Mayer and countless others.
