Attended - 3 Families (Students attend: HCP, LGS, LBCS), 2 interpreters (Ukrainian & Spanish), Amy Cima, Jill Addington, Thea Patrick

3. LCAP and CA School Dashboard

Mrs. Patrick shared an overview of the LCAP goals and how the EL program shows up in these goals. She reviewed the California Dashboard data for LUSD, sharing how this reflects the EL program. Answered some clarifying questions from a parent about ELA vs ELD data.

Mrs. Cima shared an overview of how students can progress through the EL program, toward reclassification. She shared the structure of the testing levels for the ELPAC. She shared the strength of LUSD being the size and that we can drill down to each child specifically to support them. Reclassification data for 2024-2025 was shared. She shared the joy of seeing the data for our students who reclassified. Graphs were provided to show where growth and development occurred last year. She emphasized that this data helps drive decisions on next steps. Parent question about if Franklin has an entrance exam - staff confirmed that is not accurate. Parent asked a clarifying question about how many tests their students take during the year - staff clarified CAASPP (3rd-8th only) and ELPAC tests and when they occur.

Parents were provided with a list of who supports their child at each school - classroom teacher + EL team teachers. Parent question to clarify the role of the Intervention teacher for ELA vs Math. Mrs.

Cima shared some examples of tasks that their child may experience within the ELPAC domains. Mrs. Addington shared some practice that parents could do with their child at home - these are practice questions to prepare them for the ELPAC and English development.

6. Parent Items of Interest

Parent shared that her child needs more support for math skills - asked for after-school tutoring support. Parent asked for more exposure for her child to have more English conversations. This parent was asking for some specific feedback for her child and how he is acting in class to meet the expectations for how she would like him to be. Parent expressed concern about her child's English skills as she enters TK next year. Staff listened to all families and responded with suggestions or supportive remarks. Staff will provide families with the TK/K Night event.

7. Closing
