## **Peer Editing Checklist**

<b>Editing Questions</b>	Explain how the story meets the criteria, or explain what the writer needs to fix it.
Are there any spelling or grammatical errors?	
Does the story meet MLA requirements? (font, double spaced, header, etc.)	
Does the essay have a title?	
Does the essay have a works cited page?	
Does the essay avoid the words "I, me, we, my"?	
Does the thesis follow the graphic organizer? (lists 3 examples and a universal idea)	
Does each body paragraph have a clear topic sentence?	
Does each body paragraph have at least one cited quote?	
Does every quote/example have at least one sentence of analysis which explains its connection to the thesis?	
Is the essay at least five paragraphs long?	
Does the essay clearly answer all parts of the prompt question?	
Has someone read the essay out loud to check for grammar, spelling, and organization issues?
