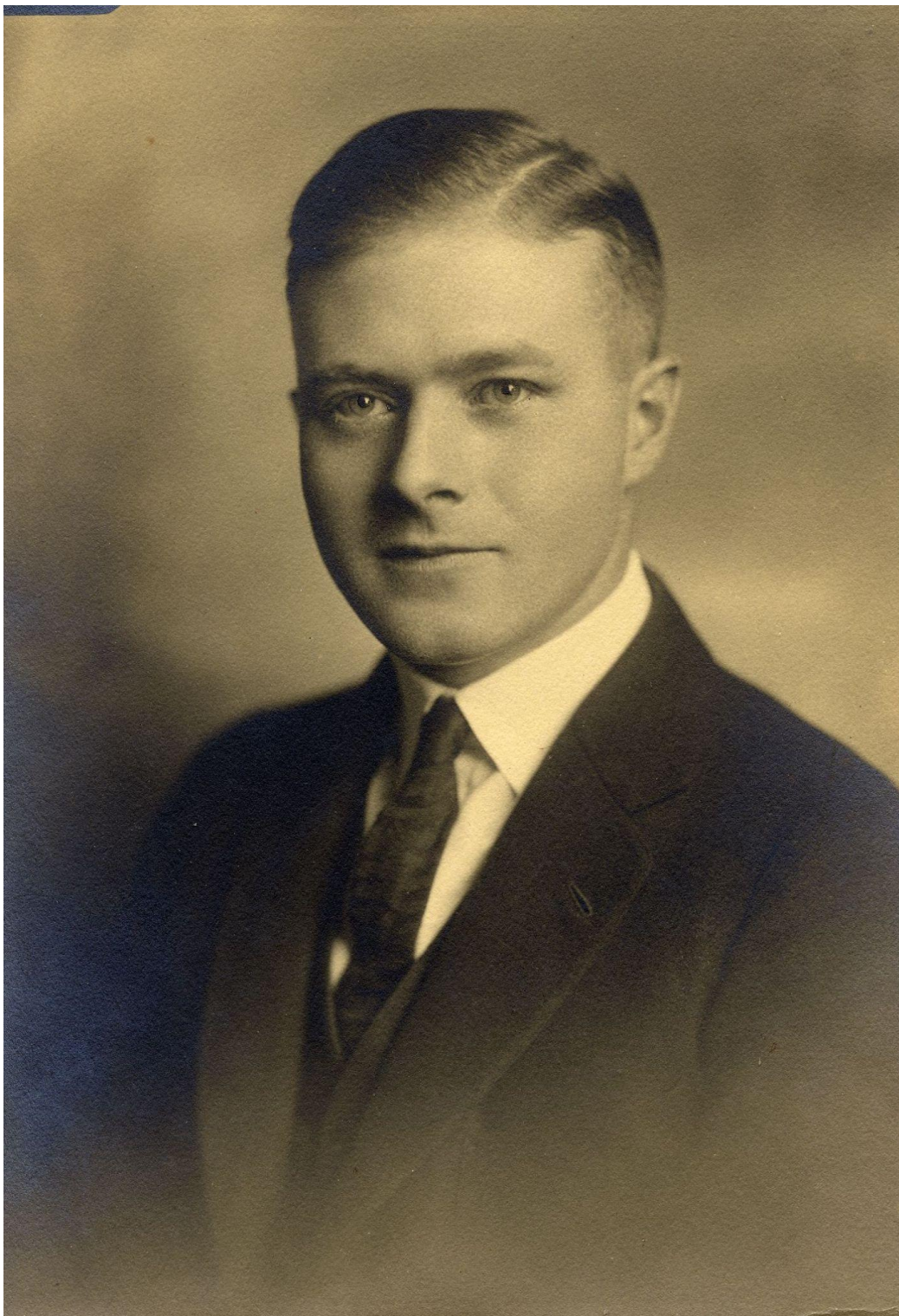


S2 Robert W. Wood

NEENAH — A memorial service will be held at a later date for Robert Wood, 85, Neenah, who died Monday, Sept. 6.

Mr. Wood was born Oct. 1, 1896, in Winnebago County, the son of Delford and Olive Cater Wood. He married Maude Millar on June 6, 1924, in Superior.

Mr. Wood was a graduate of Oshkosh High School and Oshkosh Normal School, and he attended the University of Wisconsin. He taught in Milltown, Ladysmith and Appleton. Mr. Wood was also employed by the Kimberly-Clark Corp. for 35 years, retiring in 1961.

Mr. Wood was a World War I veteran and a 50 year member of the American Legion. He was a member of First Presbyterian Church, Neenah, and served as elder and deacon.
