Class work Monitoring:

Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, A.P. with a mission to leverage the potential of ICT, in monitoring the Teaching / Learning and Progress in Collegiate Education, AP has launched an app called TLP app. Both Web application and Mobile applications are available for TLP app. This App will help the administration at various levels like CCE / RJD / Principals for knowing the number of classes scheduled, number of classes completed, number of classes deviated, number of classes recouped, etc for a single day / month.

Digital Payment System:

Web based and mobile based App “SIMS” was developed and being maintained by Commissionerate of Collegiate Education – Andhra Pradesh. With the help of this app, students can pay their fees transparently on their own pace at any time from any place. Payment gateways are provided to students in collaboration with SBI. Any level of administration can view the status of payments and Principal of any college can download reports like “Daily collection fees” , Head wise collection for every academic year per programme, etc.

Campus Connect:

It is an integrated communication management platform developed by CCE to be used by colleges to send notifications related to timetables, change of schedules, fee payment, job notifications, etc., to the students and staff . The communication platform services would aid in better administration at the college level and also reaching out to students by enabling integration of notifications such as WhatsApp, e-mail and SMS through campus connect.

Internship Monitoring:

As Internship is mandatory part of revised CBCS curriculum 2020-21 of degree colleges, CCE developed an app named I-MAP to support colleges. This Internship Monitoring App (I-Map) provides Internship opportunities to students with industry connect & monitors the status of every student in the Government degree college of our state. It monitors student attendance at industries mapped, logbook record and automate administrative tasks like daily grading etc.

Placement Monitoring:

Collegiate Education Job Portal (CEJP) is an Initiative of State Administration. This website is meant to act as a virtual meeting place for potential employees and employers. Students of all Government degree colleges of the state can register their details and upload necessary documents in CEJP. Employers will have access to data base which can be customized as per educational qualifications, experience levels and industry verticals. e-Resumes are generated automatically for students on registrations. Facilitates placement drives from the perspectives of students as well as employers.

Grievances Redressal:

Grievance Redressal Management (e-CEGRaM) App facilitates easy submission of grievances to CCE enabling quick and transparent redressal mechanism with assured follow up. Students, Staff or retired staff of any Government degree college in the state can file grievances with ease of a click & hope of assured redressal.

Website:

Commissionerate of collegiate education – Andhra Pradesh has developed a comprehensive web portal which includes data about the department and about the Government degree colleges of Andhra Pradesh. It aims at providing data about the initiatives and activities at CCE, courses offered at various Government degree colleges, notifications, etc.

File flow Management system(e-office):

Commissionerate of collegiate education, AP is committed in improving efficiency and transparency through the implementation of e-office, a digital platform that streamlines government operations. E-office eliminates paper-based processes, facilitating faster file movement, document approval, and decision-making.

Online admissions:

Commissionerate of Collegiate education, AP with the support of APSCHS is implementing an online system called the Online Admissions Module for Degree Colleges (OAMDC) for students seeking admission into undergraduate courses offered by degree colleges in the

state. This initiative aims to streamline the admissions process, making it transparent, efficient, and accessible for all students.

About CEJP

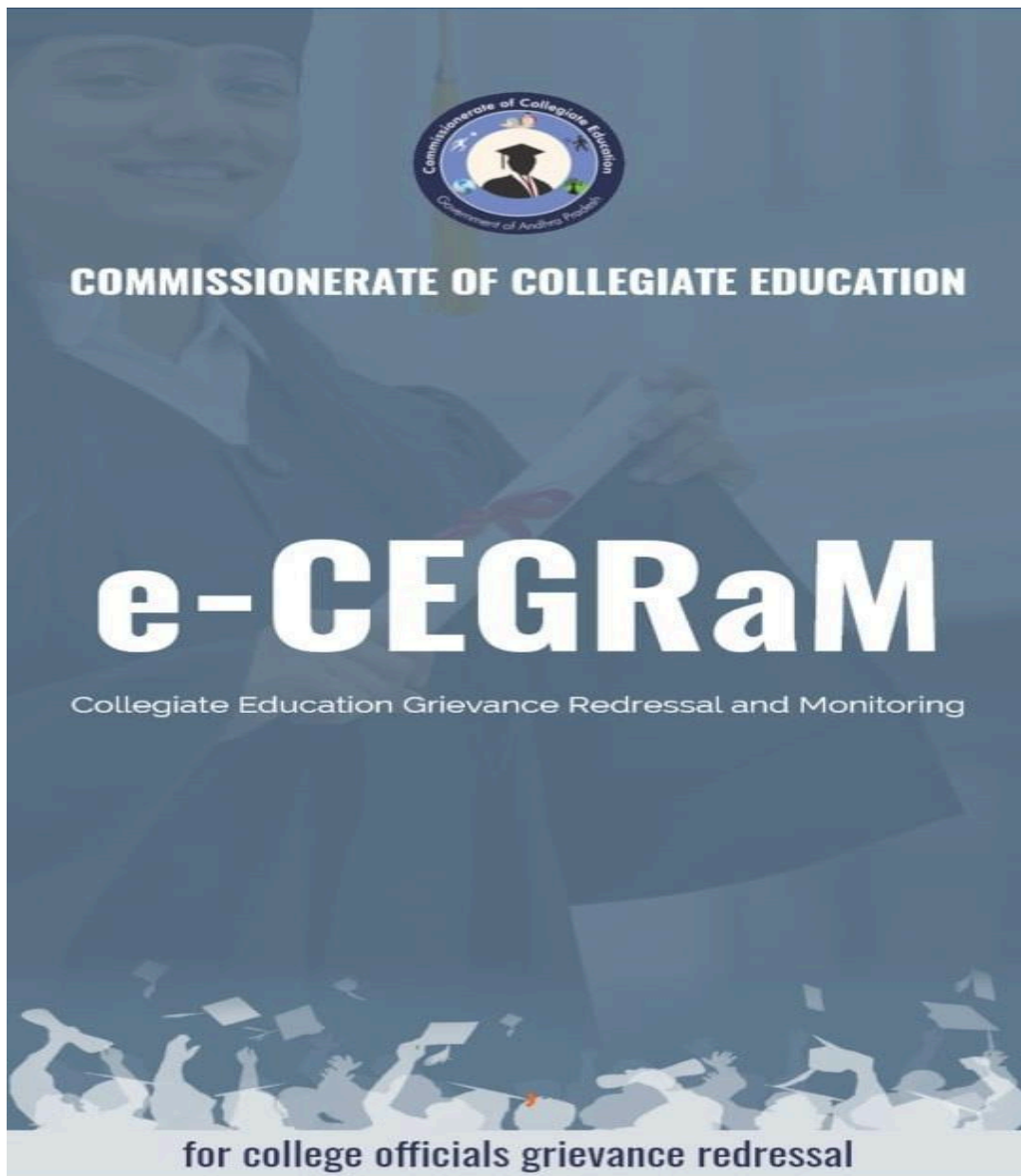
