Dear Sir, Madam, Dear Members of the LFIM community,

We're already coming to the end of our first trimester, and yes, time does fly... I'd ask you to read our newsletter very carefully, and especially the key dates in our calendar concerning "La Grande Fête du Lycée", parent/teacher meetings and the 2023 end-of-year shows.

The Lycée's educational projects are developing at great speed, and we are so happy to have teachers who are committed to the success of these projects for the benefit of our students. The main objective is to enable our students to discover the world and become the citizens of tomorrow's world.

Since last September, we've been working hard on the future of our Lycée. First of all, we submitted an application to open an American International Section (SIA) for all our students from CP to CM2 for the start of the school year in September 2024. EDUKA

LFIM is delighted to announce the launch of its new online platform on Eduka!

This is an important tool for data processing, streamlining and simplifying administrative procedures linked to school life, student enrolment, re-enrolment, withdrawal, billing, selection of extra-curricular activities and many other routine schooling processes.

To access your family's Eduka portal, please follow the steps below:

- 1. Please click here: "Retrieve lost password".
- 2. Enter the e-mail address you provided on your registration form when you registered your student(s). Parents may note that their email addresses have already been added by us to the Eduka system.
- 3. Once you have accessed your account, please follow the requested steps and update your child(ren)'s details.
- 4. Please keep your email address and password safe, as they will be used to access your account.

Please note:

- 1. Registration on Eduka is compulsory for all families whose students are enrolled at LFIM.
- 2. Parents are requested to use only the email address given on the registration form when registering their student(s).
- 3. If this email does not work, please try the most recent email you used to communicate with the school. This may also be your company email address.
- 4. Both parents have access to the family account.
- 5. All student information must be regularly updated by families. This includes copies of passports, FRROs, visas, etc.
- 6. The contact details of all persons authorized to pick up the student (driver, nanny, friends, grandparents, etc.) must be regularly updated on Eduka by the parents.

The school and Eduka are firmly committed to respecting and guaranteeing the confidentiality of all data concerning our students and their families.

LUNCH SERVICE AT LFIM

Created by Zane's Café, this service is designed specifically for our students and staff, with different meal plans and pricing options available. To place your orders, please click on the following link: https://meals.zanes.coffee/

Steps for using the website:

- 1. Please create an account to order your meals. To avoid confusion, we ask that parents <u>create</u> only one account per family.
- 2. Please create a password that will be used each time you log in.
- 3. The same account must be used for all students in a family. **Do not create multiple accounts** for each student.
- 4. You can choose prepaid plans (for 2 weeks) or order for a specific day.
- 5. Parents must clearly state their child's full name (first and last) and class to avoid confusion at the end of the order. For more than one child, parents are asked to place a separate order from the same account OR to clearly state the name and class of the other child(ren) in the comments section. Since this information will be on the food box, we ask that parents be very careful when filling out this field.
- 6. Since this service is for LFIM, it is not necessary to add the school address when ordering. Simply indicate 'LFIM' in the requested fields.

Please note:

- 1. This service is open to all students (TPS Terminale) and LFIM staff.
- 2. This is an optional service. Students are encouraged to bring their own lunch from home, and are required to bring their own snacks, as this service is for lunch only.
- 3. In the event of a holiday/school vacation, paid days (prepaid plans) will be moved to the next business day.
- 4. If you have any information you would like to share with the caterer, or if your child(ren) have any allergies, please indicate this in the comments section when ordering.
- 5. The delivery weeks of the meals are mentioned on the website.

Although this service was created in partnership with Zané's Café, LFIM is not responsible for the delivery of the meals, the ingredients used or the operation of the website.

END OF CLASS PROTOCOL

Please note that parents must send us an email for any change in the person(s) authorized to pick up students after school.

For your reference, here is the protocol:

- An email should be sent to Ms. Varsha at <u>bienvenue@lfim.in</u> clearly indicating the child's name and class.
- 2. If this is a new driver or nanny, parents should upload a clear copy of their driving license or national ID card (Aadhar/PAN etc) to Eduka.
- 3. You should also copy Rohan (communication@lfim.in) and the student's respective teachers (if possible) on the e-mail.
- 4. A reply to your email will always be sent within an hour of receipt.
- 5. Parents must send an email to the school no later than one hour before the student's pick-up time. Messages sent via WhatsApp or phone calls will not be taken into account.
- 6. If we do not receive an email and a new person or parent picks up the student, the student will be asked to stay at school and the family will be contacted.

Please note that apart from Varsha, Rohan or the teachers concerned, no other person has the authority to allow a student to leave the school premises with a new nanny/driver/classmate or the classmate's parent.


A few steps to follow.

AIR POLLUTION PROTOCOL

Due to the increase in air pollution in and around Mumbai here is our protocol that is implemented daily at the school.

In the classrooms:

- We have new air purifiers in all classrooms. These purifiers use the new Plasmacluster purification technology and are equipped with HEPA filters.
 (https://www.epa.gov/indoor-air-quality-iag/what-hepa-filter).
- All classroom windows are kept closed to prevent dust from entering and can only be opened by an authorized staff member.

During break time:

- Before each recess, the teacher checks the pollution level before allowing the children to
 play in the outdoor playground. If the pollution level reaches 200 (bad), students are not
 allowed to play outside and are moved to the indoor playground. We use an app called Safar,
 created by the Indian government to monitor the air quality index (AQI):
 http://safar.tropmet.res.in/
- The indoor playground has a dedicated air conditioning system with built-in air filters and an air cleaning system that purifies the air and allows students to play in a comfortable environment.

On campus:

 Masks remain available throughout campus in case a student wishes to wear one when leaving school at the end of the day or wishes to wear one at school.
