Zoom Tips	1. New: Zoom - Moving Co-Hosts Around Breakout Rooms to have your Aide assist during Zoom.

SeeSaw Tips	1. New: Students are automatically logged in via Clever. 2. New: Teachers SeeSaw classes are automatically created. 3. Invite ALL families to SeeSaw - This is what parents will see 4. Add your grade level and SpEd as co-teachers (up to 20 co-teachers) 5. Find MSD SeeSaw Activities and Share activities with other teachers 6. Differentiate activities and assign to specific students 7. Consider using the New Drafts and schedule features in SeeSaw
