	will result in a fee of \$25 or applicants may not be eligible to wrestle. Please include a RATING for each elementary athlete: (4 = Outstanding; 3 = Good; 2 = Average; 1 = Beginner). COACHES	To receive a coach accreditation (eligible to coach during the event), coaches must be registered with their provincial/state body. It is recommended that coaches have completed the following elements and have them recorded in their NCCP transcripts: • Make Ethical Decisions Evaluation • Community coaching • Working towards Competitive Introduction
ENTRY FEES	Elementary The cost for the entering wrestlers in the elementary division is \$25 if entered by the March 5, 2024, deadline. The cost for entering wrestlers in the U16 & U19

divisions is \$35 if entered by the March 5 deadline. Adult Novice Division: Open to ages 18-55. As this is adult novice, wrestlers that have competed on a varsity university/college program are ineligible. The cost for entering wrestlers in the Adult Novice Open division is \$40 if entered by the March 5 deadline All entries received after March 5, 2024, will be subject to a \$25 late fee per athlete entered. No registrations will be accepted after March 7, 2024, at 11:59pm PST. **RULES** Elementary • Modified BC High School rules will be used for both divisions U16 (WCL U15 rules will apply), U19 & Adult Open • Wrestling Canada Lutte 2022–2023 rules (TBD) will apply with a modified double elimination bracket system Medals will be handed out to all elementary **AWARDS** wrestlers. For the remaining divisions, the top three in each weight class will receive a medal. Plaques will be awarded to the top three clubs of each division.
