***Important Notes:**

- Please keep in mind that students will carry their backpacks from class to class, therefore, no "Rolling Backpacks" are allowed.
- Please do not bring white-out (liquid or tape).

General school supplies for all subjects include:

- Two Classic Blue or Black Ink pens daily (no brightly colored ink please)
- #2 Pencils and extra eraser if needed
- Pencil Sharpener **with Cover**
- Highlighters
- Lightweight pencil case (for all writing supplies)
- Stapler (Please make sure you have a full sized stapler **at home** and/or a mini-stapler for school.)
- Index Cards (6 packages)
- Travel Packs of tissues in backpack daily**
- Headphones or Plug - in earbuds (NO Bluetooth or AirPods)
