

EduJunior Online International Public Speaking Contest Guidelines

Eligibility:

- Open to children and teens between **6 to 17 years**.
- Participants must obtain prior permission from their parents, legal guardians, or teachers to enter the competition.

Format & Submission:

- **Mode:** 100% Online
- **Language:** English
- **Speech Duration:**
 - **Category A (6–8 years)** : 1–2 minutes
 - **Category B (9–11 years)** : 2–3 minutes
 - **Category C (12–14 years)** : 3–4 minutes
 - **Category D (15–17 years)** : 4–5 minutes
- Speeches must be **memorized or extemporaneous**. Reading from a paper or screen is not allowed.
- Participants must choose **one theme** from the two provided and submit a **video recording** of their speech.

Themes (Choose One)

Category A (6–8 years)

1. If I had a superpower
2. My favorite animal and why I love it

Category B (9–11 years)

1. One thing I would change in the world
2. Books vs. Screens: What I prefer and why

Category C (12–14 years)

1. Why it's important to stand up for others
2. Technology: Friend or distraction for kids?

Category D (15–17 years)

1. The power of youth to shape the future
2. Social media: Voice for change or cause for concern?

Entry Fee and Registration:

- There is an entry fee of **INR 399**, payable upon registration.
- To register and submit your entry, please fill out the online registration form provided and proceed with the payment.
- Registration will be closed on **July 10th, 2025**.

Application Process:

- **Step 1: Registration**
 - Fill out the registration form.
 - Ensure all details are filled in accurately.
 - Make the payment as required.
 - Receive the payment receipt via email.

- **Step 2: Performance Submission**
 - Upload your public speaking video to any platform (YouTube, Facebook, Instagram, Google Drive, Dropbox, etc.).
 - Tag **#EduJunior** if posting on social media.
 - After registration, you will receive a submission link on WhatsApp & Email.
 - Submit your video link via the provided form by **July 15th, 2025**.

- **Step 3: Announcement and Awards**
 - Wait for the announcement period where winners and runners-up will be declared.
 - Certificates and awards will be awarded to the winners and runners-up.

Evaluation Criteria:

- Performances will be judged based on relevance to the theme, originality and creativity, message and clarity, structure and coherence, presentation skills (voice, gestures, confidence).
- The Judges' evaluation will determine the final outcome for each participant.

- **Runners-Up:**
 - a. Gold Medal
 - b. Hard Copy of Certificate

 - a. Offline Certificate of Participation
- **Teacher in Charge:**
 - a. Appreciation Certificate
