Autumn Term first half newsletter 2023 Message from Mrs Buckley

Hello and welcome to our first newsletter of the new school year. We have had a wonderful first week seeing all of the children back and ready to learn. We have gathered back your responses to the Breakfast Club and Play Date Club. The responses for a Breakfast Club were very few and not enough to make it viable at present. However, there were a lot of requests for the "Play Date" one and we will therefore commence this next Tuesday (12th September) - 3.15 until 5.00pm. The cost will be £5.00 and this payment can be made via the MCAS app, under the clubs tab.

We have also been asked about extending this offer to another evening and we are therefore sending out another form to see what the interest is to hold another one on a Thursday after school.

The "Play Date" Club is in addition to our normal Monday After School Club which will commence on Monday 18th September. There will be further information coming about this next week with a form to sign. The weekly contribution for this remains at £2.00 per session with cash being sent in as we use this money to cover materials required for the sessions.

School contact details and pupil consent forms are attached to be completed and returned to school as soon as possible so that we can ensure all our details are up to date.

School meals - Year 3 and 4 children lunch money. School meals are £12 per week or £91.20 up to half term. Payments to be made on the My Child At School app - please ensure that your account does not go into arrears.

Milk - If your child is five years of age and you wish them to receive milk at school during their milk and fruit time, it will be £10 per term, payable on the My Child At School app.

Are you entitled to Pupil Premium?

If you are eligible for Pupil Premium you will then have access to the following benefits:

Paid residential year 3 and year 4.

One pair of school shoes per year, two jumpers/polo shirts and bottoms per year and 1 set of PE kit (up to the value of £125).

All school visits, Breakfast club and After school club costs will be met.
