The board meeting of the HLV Community School District was held on October 9, 2024, at 5:00 pm. President Doran called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm.

Roll call resulted in board members Hawkins, Doran, Kupka and Kuesel being present, a quorum was declared. Henning was absent. Also present were Superintendent Hohensee, Lori McClenathan, Mark Tegeler, Butch Mitchell, Raelene Hawkins, and Ellie Hawkins.

Kuesel read the Mission Statement "Teaching our Youth of Today to be Leaders of Tomorrow". Doran then read the President's Statement.

Kupka motioned to approve the consent agenda items, which included approval of the previous amended meeting minutes, approval of current bills and additional bills, approval of financial reports, and facility use requests, Fund Raising requests, resignation from Cory Lahndorf, Industrial Tech teacher and coaching contracts (effective May 30), TLC positions., employment offer to Quince Smith, volunteer Asst.
