

PROFESSIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES

The teacher is responsible for following the approved scope and sequence of the curriculum and for encouraging each child to progress in terms of his/her ability. This implies initiative by the teacher. The teacher shall acquaint himself/herself with available instructional materials and shall effectively utilize them. The teacher shall maintain such records as are required; he/she shall observe the intent of the procedures used in reporting to parents. Good discipline is an important responsibility of the teacher and he/she should seek help when ever he/she feels that discipline of an individual child (or group of children) requires something more than he/she has been able to develop. Appropriate standards for classroom order and neatness, attention to the health and safety of pupils, participation in school activities outside of regular school hours, pursuit of additional professional knowledge and skill and an awareness of the teacher's important role in public relations, may reasonably be expected from the teacher.

The teacher is directly responsible to the building principal, and through him/her to the superintendent of schools. Each teacher shall discharge his/her duties in accordance with the policies of the board as outlined herein, and the rules and instructions of the board, superintendent and principal.
