- 1) While UC doesn't have a union catalog for all materials, there is a robust set of data for system-wide electronic resources in our SFX instances & bib records (SCP set of record) within UCSD's Millennium catalog. How to handle SFX data (system-wide + campus data) & merge into NZ with analogous shared cataloging records? Can/Should the system-wide SFX/SCP data for electronic resources be leveraged, or do as though there were 10 campus (IZ) instances? - Alison Ray, 3/12/2020
- 2) Could an IZ (or NZ) be populated with a subset of records from a campus? (eg. the system-wide electronic bib records into the NZ) Alison Ray, 3/12/2020
- 3) How/where does SFX data get ingested?
- 4) Any estimate on staff/programmer time/involvement for Vanguard participants, this would help campuses make informed decisions on whether they could join the vanguard.
- 5) Does a Vanguard campus have to migrate everything, or can a campus selectively decide what gets migrated? Is there a benefit to the systemwide effort if a campus has a particular functional area that might be good to test in the Vanguard environment?
