So far above all of the rest.



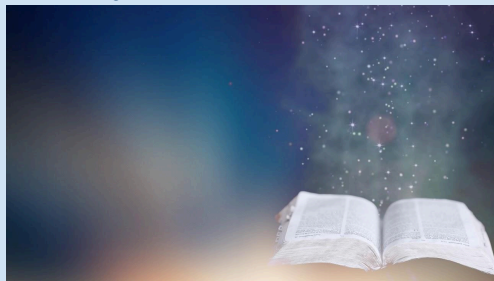
Yet men deride and denigrate it,
