During your 5 months as a Squad Leader you are responsible for the following:

- ☐ Personal relationship with God
- ☐ Knowing & leading self
- ☐ Leading from a place of rest (not performance)
 - Mandatory day off each week
- ☐ Relationship with co leaders
 - Call at least 1 other SQL 1x week
 - Get together with co leaders at the end of each month for 1 night in a hostel; treat yourselves to dinner on squad budget & hang out like friends
- ☐ Weekly leadership call with SQM+coaches
- ☐ Weekly one-on-one call with SQM or coach
- ☐ Weekly call or one-on-one with TLs you are discipling
- ☐ Facilitate the following team times (or make sure TL does this):
 - Worship
 - Journey Markers
 - Blogging
 - Super feedback
- ☐ Stay with each team you are leading minimum 7-10 days, participate in ministry
- ☐ One-on-ones with team, using this time to press into healing, growth, and discipleship
- ☐ Keep SQM up to date with how ministry is going / if there are any issues
- ☐ Make sure all FIRS reports are filled out in a timely manner
- ☐ Run point on any serious health situations (staying with racer in hospital, dealing with insurance, communicating with SQM, possibly flying to another hospital/country)
- ☐ Work with SQM/SQA/logistics leaders to plan MDBs/travel days/debriefs
- ☐ Stay on top of SQL finances
- ☐ Stay on top of personal fundraising
- ☐ Hold racers accountable to the Expectations of a Racer
 - Kingdom Mindset
 - Desire to Grow
 - Positive Attitude
 - Self-governance (no drugs and boundaries on alcohol)

- Community (includes discipling each other & feedback)
- Relationships (no dating)
- Telling your story (blogging)
- Physical fitness
- ❑ Emphasize 3 circles in how you lead/everything you do:
 - Intimacy with the Lord
 - Community with body of believers
 - Missional living
