2025 Minnesota State Fair 4-H Senior General Livestock Judging Contest

St. Paul, MN (8/20/25) - Hundreds of Minnesota 4-Hers spend their summer evenings evaluating cattle, hogs, and sheep/goats. In addition to conducting the evaluations 4-H'ers learn the art of oral reasons as a means of justifying their placing. Experience gained in judging livestock helps a participant select future projects and replacements for their own herd ventures. The judging experience truly helps 4-H members base their decisions on sound reasons and implement several new life skills. This year 59 individuals and 15 teams participated in the senior competition.

Dakota/Washington County placed first with a total of 1774 points. Jackson/Nobles/Brown County placed second with 1749 total points. The team from Meeker/Kandiyohi County finished in third with 1745 total points. Freeborn County 2 took fourth place with 1725 points and Rice County finished in fifth with 1719 points.

Colton Herman of Dakota/Washington County took home the high individual honors with 617 points. Schuyler Sullivan of Dodge County placed second with 616 points. Jack Van Nurden of Meeker/KandiyohiCounty placed third overall with 613 points. In fourth place was Levi Thompson of Jackson/Nobles/Brown County with 593 points and in fifth place was Claire Bottelson from Freeborn County 2 with 588 points.

The first place team in Beef was Jackson/Nobles/Brown County and second place was Dakota/Washington County. The top individual in Beef was Emily Hass of Mille Lacs/Isanti County and Brock Nissen of Jackson/Nobles/Brown County took second.

The first place team in Sheep/Goats was Jackson/Nobles/Brown County and second place was Freeborn County. The top individual in Sheep/Goats was Noah Gravenhof of

Jackson/Nobles/Brown County and Levi Thompson of Jackson/Nobles/Brown County took second.

The first place team in Swine was **Dakota/Washington County** and second place was **Rice County**. The top individual in Swine was **Colton Herman** of **Dakota/Washington County** and **Jack Van Nurden** of **Meeker/Kandiyohi County** took second.

The first place team in Reasons was **Dakota/Washington County** and second place was **Rice County**. The top individual in Reasons was **Wyatt Herman** of **Dakota/Washington County** and **Colton Herman** of **Dakota/Washington County** took second.
