I have to tell y'all, after watching a bunch of webinars lately with incredibly bright, energetic and young folks - and mostly women - I have much more hope than I have had in a very long time. The most exciting was the one I did last night about the The First Ever Global Conference on Fossil Fuels in Santa Marta, Colombia. First, all 4 panelists were young and inspiring women and what they had to report on was a new coalition of the willing - countries that are interested in eliminating fossil fuels - Coalition on Phasing Out Fossil Fuel Incentives Including Subsidies (COFFIS) (Did not include the US.) I highly recommend that you check out the recording in NOTES and the summary in RESOURCES.

I have received a plea for help on working with an established program of Adopt a Highway Cleanup events. We would be collaborating with Dem Women of Moore County, and the role would be to schedule quarterly events, pick up the supplies from Carthage, and submit a report after the event. They really need someone to take this role - it is not political - and it would be a logical thing for a CCWG member to do. Please be in touch if you have any interest.

And finally, there will be no Dump next weekend as we will be playing with the grandkids, and the following weekend will have PRIDEfest Saturday and No Kings on Sunday, so I think the next Dump will be coming out on June 15. So you have lots of time to read through this one. 😊

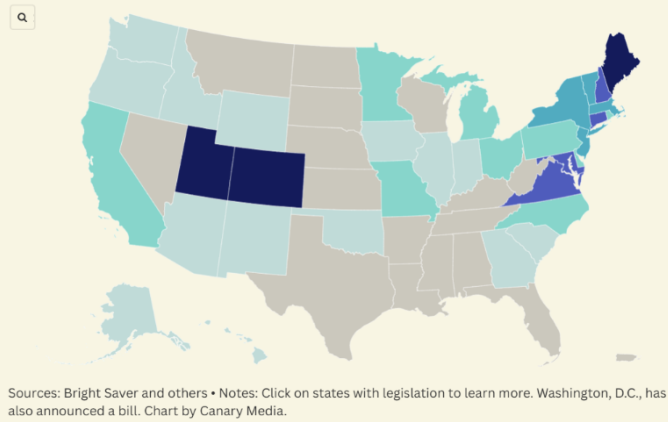

Hint for scanning and saving items in the Dump for future reading: Forward this Dump email to yourself but don't hit Send. Scroll through the Dump in that open email to find items you want to go back to. When you find an item you want to revisit, put some symbols at the beginning of the first line, like *** or ##### or something that will catch your eye later. Send the email to yourself and in the new email go back and find the items you highlighted or noted and click on those links. Let me know if this works for you. Hope so!
