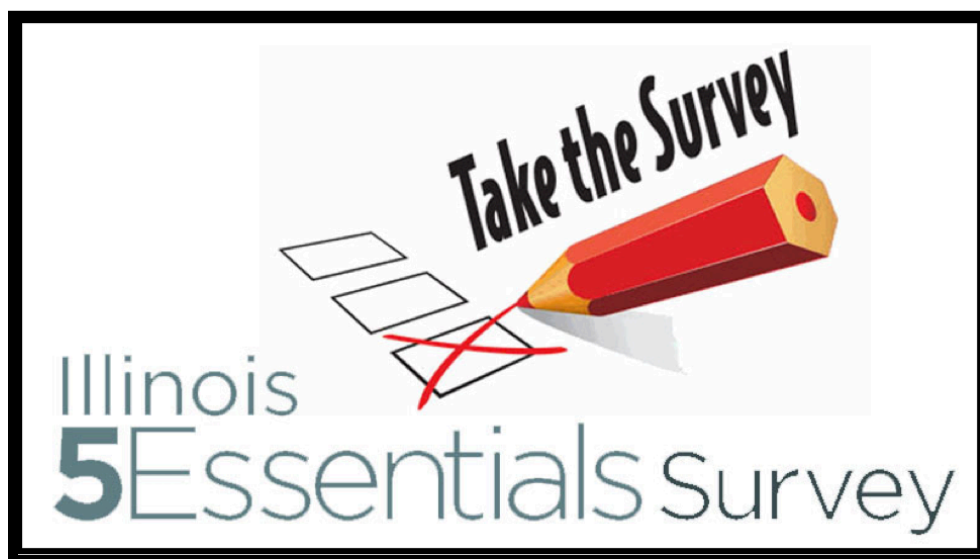

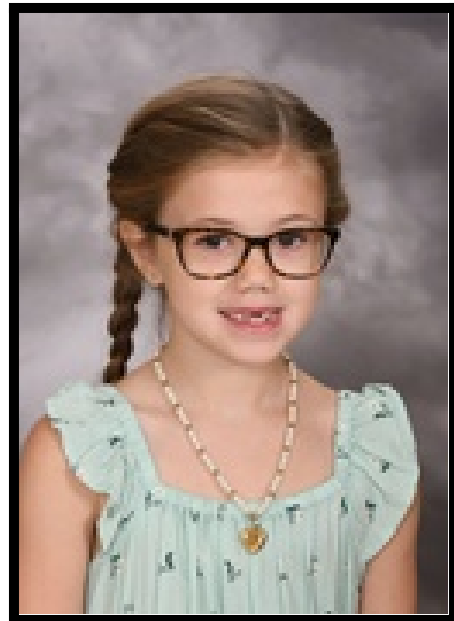
Triad Prenatal to 3 Program News!

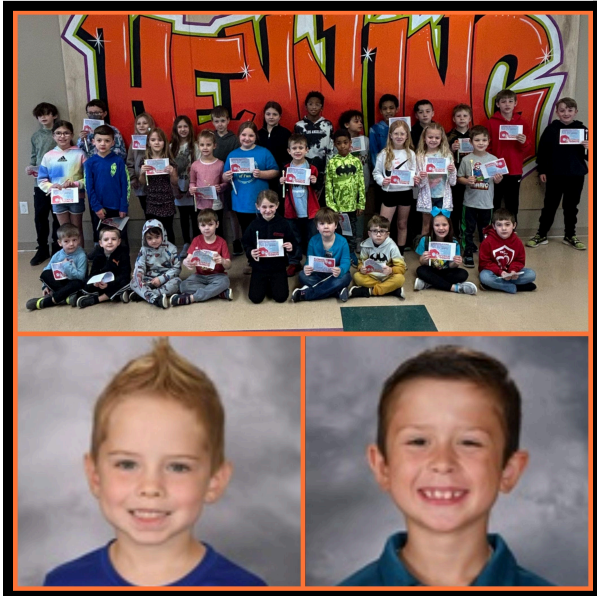

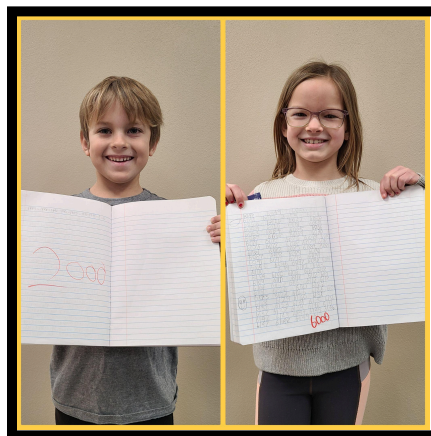
