Course Overview:

Examples of extenuating circumstances: car accident, sudden illness, etc. Students should arrange a "back up plan" in case of unexpected computer problems the day of the class (i.e. make pre-arrangements to go to a neighbor, friend, relative, library, etc.)

When students are absent, they must contact the instructor via email, watch the class recording and submit a summary of the recorded class. In addition, all assignments that are posted in Canvas are to be turned in.
