Day 3

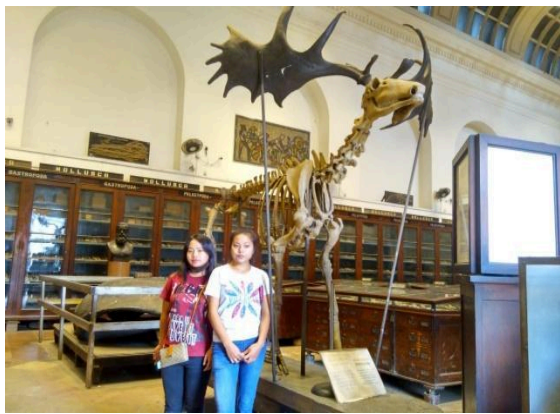

Day 4


