

Automatically Collected Information and General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

Our new Privacy Policy (July 24, 2018) reflects the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) standards and **applies to all apps that we will release after that date**. In short, we do not collect your personal data. We only collect anonymous statistical information, however our ads suppliers may use advertising ID of your device to provide more relevant ads based on your personal preferences. - Our apps may contain "feedback", "tell a friend", "rate now" and/or "gift now" buttons. These buttons are found on a contained, parent targeted screen separate from game play screens and are only accessible through a "press and hold" button.
- Our apps may contain in app purchases to enable additional content. These in app purchases are purchased only once and may be re-activated across all of your devices of the same type.

- If you submit a support request, we'll need your name and email address in order to contact you. In the event that a user contacts us through a support request, and identifies himself or herself as a child under the age of 13, we will not collect, store or use any personal information of that user, and will delete all information about that user in a secure manner.
