7. Determine council vacancies for next year. Watching [this video](#) may help remind you about council openings and elections. As a reminder:

- "Parent/Guardian Eligibility – The parent or guardian has a student who will be enrolled at the school at any time during the two-year term."
- "Parent member" may not include an educator who is employed at the school."
- Parent Positions are for 2-year terms and should be staggered, with no more than 50% of positions open in any given year. One-year terms may be necessary to be in compliance.
- Council size is determined by each individual school council. Patron members should outnumber employee members by two.
- Community council meeting dates and times are posted on the school website, along with the agenda, at least a week before the meeting. Should a council meeting need to be canceled or changed, update the council schedule on the website, giving at least a week's notice where possible.
