# **WINTER 2025 I**

Candidates earn credit in MIDAS for their Professional Learning Plan - Course **I** Learning Environment, Curriculum Instruction & Planning, and Diverse Learners by:

- ★ Attending and actively participating in at least 90% of the face-to-face training.
- ★ Completing all tasks in **Units 1, 2, and 3** by **Tuesday, September 23, 2025 by 12:00 NOON**.
- ★ Completing all tasks in **Unit 4**.
- ★ Earning a passing score (3 or 4) on each of the four written responses of the Pedagogical Demonstration TASK 1: *Knowledge of Students and the Learning Environment.*

**Rationale:** The tasks and accompanying due dates enable candidates to <u>demonstrate</u> the pedagogy discussed in all 37 Utah Competencies in their classroom on a <u>regular basis</u> and receive feedback throughout.

Unit 1 - To demonstrate proficiency with Learning Environment, Curriculum, Instruction & Planning, and Diverse Learners

#### 1A - DUE DATE - Submitted to Canvas Before Class on February 18th

- Establish Expectations Rough Draft. Bring the finished rough draft to class next time (front and back). Each expectation must include the 1) definition, 2) rationale, and 3) critical discrimination. <u>Granite Characteristics</u> and <u>Behavior Supports</u>.
- 2. **Know Your Students.** Create or choose TWO meaningful, whole-class activities that illustrate you are getting to know your students to build positive relationships. For each activity, include 1) the <u>date</u> you will give it to students 2) an <u>example</u> of the activity, and 3) the <u>plan</u> for how you will use the information learned about your students in your classroom decisions. (approx 250 words). Bring the dates, two examples, and the plan to class next time.

#### 1B - DUE DATE - Submitted to Canvas Before Class on March 4th

- 3. **Establish Procedures**. Establish at least 10 procedures using the <u>template</u> for explicit teaching from training. Upload 10 completed templates.
- 4. **Plan Book Structure.** Upload evidence of your structured plan book adhering to the rubric in column 2 of <u>Lesson Design</u>. Give us a link set to "Anyone With a Link May View."
- 5. **Classroom Culture**. Upload 2-3 photos and a written explanation that explains HOW your classroom demonstrates a clean, safe, and student-centered environment. (approx 250 words)

## 1C - DUE DATE - Submitted to Canvas Before Class on March 25th

- 6. Classroom Expectations Visible. Upload a picture(s) of each of your finished 3-5 visible classroom expectations posted on the wall, large enough for students to read from their desks. Each expectation must include the 1) definition, 2) rationale, and 3) critical discrimination. Granite Characteristics and Behavior Supports.
- 7. **Plan Book Feb/March 2025**. Enter 3 weeks of <u>content</u> in your plan book for each course you teach AND complete the <u>plan book scoring guide</u>. Upload your completed scoring guide and plan book evidence with the link set to "anyone with the link may view."

- 8. **Explicitly Teach Procedures**. Follow the five (5) <u>Guidelines for Recording Classroom Videos</u>. **Video** a lesson showing you <u>explicitly teaching</u> or re-teaching a procedure to your students. Make sure the video includes all four steps of explicitly teaching a procedure: 1) state, 2) rationale, 3) critical discrimination, and 4) model and practice. Upload a link to the video. *0.5 hour clinical experience*.
- Seating Charts. Upload a photo of EACH of your seating chart(s) and an analysis for ONE class of how you determined which students to seat <u>near each other</u> and in various <u>locations in the room</u> (approx 250 words).

# 1D - DUE DATE - Submitted to Canvas Before Class on April 15th

- 10. **Visible Learning**. **Video** a lesson that makes learning visible because students are writing, speaking and/or making physical responses consistent with the objective. Complete the <u>Self Observation Video</u> <u>Reflection</u> form. Upload the completed form with a link to the video. *1 hour clinical experience*.
- 11. **Plan Book April 2025.** Enter at least 3 weeks of <u>content</u> in your plan book for each course you teach AND complete the <u>plan book scoring guide</u>. Upload your completed scoring guide and plan book evidence with the link set to "anyone with the link may view."
- 12. **Course Timelines.** Create or revise your timelines for <u>each subject</u> you teach for at least 3rd-4th terms using the <u>timeline template</u>. Upload your completed timelines with the link set to "anyone with link may view."
- 13. **Modeling**. **Video** about 10-15 minutes of a lesson that shows you modeling with your current students. The teacher and students are doing the same task simultaneously. *0.5 hour clinical experience*.
- 14. **Communicating with Families.** Upload an example of a communication sent to ALL families in at least one class. Give <u>at least 3</u> examples of how this communication built relationships with your students' families.

Unit 2 - To demonstrate proficiency with Learning Environment, Curriculum, Instruction & Planning, and Diverse Learners

## 2A - DUE DATE - Submitted to Canvas Before Class on April 29th

- 15. **Positively Reinforce and Correct Errors. Video** about 15 minutes of a lesson showing you <u>positively reinforcing and correcting errors</u> using effective teaching skills and positive praise. (1) Watch the video and keep track of the data on the <u>Effective Teaching Skills</u> form. (2) Write a reflection on what you learned (approx 250 words). Upload the link to the video, completed form with tally marks, and written reflection. *0.5 hour clinical experience*.
- 16. **Know Your Students & School Artifacts.** Compile the "Knowing My Students and Classroom" artifact that demonstrates you know about the non-academic interest(s), academic strengths, unique learning needs and home demographics of your current students (upload <u>at least one class</u>). Compile the "School Profile Spreadsheet" artifact. Create a file for this task that includes the links to each artifact.
- 17. **Plan Book May 2025.** Enter at least 3 weeks of <u>content</u> in your plan book for each course you teach AND complete the <u>plan book scoring guide</u>. Upload your completed scoring guide and plan book evidence with the link set to "anyone with the link may view."

# 2B - DUE & MARKED COMPLETE Before Friday, May 9, 2025 at 12:00 NOON

- 18. **Monitoring Learning**. Upload a <u>finished example</u> of a tool you use DURING class time to keep track of individual students as they progress in a lesson or unit (eg/ anecdotal notes). Submit a <u>description</u> of how the tool was used to monitor progress (approx 150 words). Upload the finished tool and description.
- 19. Universal Design for Learning. Complete the Universal Design for Learning form and upload it.

Unit 3 - To demonstrate proficiency with Learning Environment, Curriculum, Instruction & Planning, and Diverse Learners

- 20. **Plan Book Aug/Sept 2025**. Enter at least 3 weeks of <u>content</u> in your plan book for each course you teach AND complete the <u>plan book scoring guide</u>. Upload your completed scoring guide and plan book evidence with the link set to "anyone with the link may view."
- 21. **Communicating with Families.** Upload an example of a communication sent to ALL families in one class. Give at least 3 examples of how this communication built relationships with your students' families.

# **Submitted to Canvas Before Class on September 11th**

- 22. Data, Decisions, Strategies. Complete the <u>Instruction Practice sheet</u> that we started in class.
- 23. **Parent Communication.** Upload an example of a communication sent to ALL families in the class that expects a response of information. 1) Give 2+ examples of how it fostered a positive relationship with individual students. 2) Give 2+ examples of how it encouraged continued communication with you and your students' families. 3) Finally, describe how the data from this communication influenced an instructional decision that affected your whole class.
- 24. Non-Response. Based on the communication method you sent out from the task above, discuss what you would do the <u>same</u> and <u>differently</u> in each of the three areas of non-response 1) design,2) accessibility and 3) value if you choose to use it again (approx 250 words). Upload the written response.
