4. Communication is a key to success in this program, so **parents and students MUST** join the REMIND groups for the appropriate grade level. Text the grade level code to 81010.

5. Daily Habits:

- I. Students should be up and working at 8AM, and students should plan to <u>spend at least 45 minutes to an hour on each subject in Apex EVERY DAY.</u> Use the <u>suggested schedule</u> linked below. Students can take a short break between classes to stretch and go to the bathroom.

- II. Each morning, students should check their school email, Google classroom, and Apex messages. To find your APEX MESSAGES, go to your Apex dashboard, find MESSAGES, and click on VIEW. Read each new message.
- III. Use the Apex calendar to see assignments that are upcoming. DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE DUE DATE TO BEGIN THE ASSIGNMENT. Remember, the overview, study section, and study guide should be completed BEFORE attempting the practice, quiz, and test.

USING APEX

*How do I find Apex? Go to the Google Waffle (upper right corner). Find and click on the Apex app. You do not need a username or password.

- 6. Apex is an **INDEPENDENT LEARNING PROGRAM.** Students must spend the majority of their time in the STUDY SECTION since this is where the learning takes place. Students will read passages, study infographics and key terms, and complete a study guide.
- 7. Teachers can see how much time students spend in each section of the Apex program. Please watch the attached video about How to Navigate in Apex.

- 9. <u>It is very important to go through the program in order:</u> The Overview, Study Section with Study Guide, and Check Up must be completed before moving on to any graded assignment (such as a practice, journal, quiz, or test).
- 10. Your teachers are here to HELP; however, you must do your part by reading and completing all parts of the overview, study section, study guide, and check ups. If you struggle with reading, use the Read To option. Please let your teacher know if you are coming to the COA lab or to the school for help. Your teachers are in the lab and in the middle school on specific days.
- 11. <u>Practice assignments and Journals are graded by the teacher</u>. Students will not be able to type directly on these assignments. Please watch the <u>WORKING WITH EDITABLE ASSIGNMENT SHEETS</u> (<u>GOOGLE</u>)video THIS HAS CHANGED SINCE LAST YEAR. You may need to watch this a couple of times.

- 12. Once you've completed the assignment and saved it, you must now turn it in. Follow these steps to turn in your work through Apex. https://support.apexlearning.com/help/messages/attach
- 13. The Apex program will automatically lock if a student fails a quiz on a second attempt. The student will need to contact the teacher if the program is locked. If a student fails a quiz on the first attempt, it is essential to go back and spend time in the Study Section and Study Guide before attempting the quiz a second time. If you do not pass the

quiz on the second attempt, your teacher may require you to submit the study guide, watch extra help videos, and complete IXL lessons before allowing you to move on OR before unlocking the quiz for a 3rd and final attempt. OUR GOAL FOR YOU IS TO LEARN THE MATERIAL.

14. Parents and guardians receive a WEEKLY grade report from Apex. These are sent out each Sunday. Parents, if you do not receive this weekly report, please notify one of the Apex teachers and check your SPAM folder. The link below explains how to read the weekly report.
