C. Was passt nicht? [=What doesn't fit?]

Schreiben Sie **drei** "Was passt nicht?" [=What doesn't fit?] Fragen mit den Kapitel 2 Vokabeln.

z.B. *a. bald* *b. heute* *c. allein* *d. morgens*
 ==> "*Allein*" passt nicht, denn [=because] es hat nichts mit Zeit zu tun [=it has nothing to do with time].

Notes:

- It's OK to use English or "Denglisch" when you give the reason (i.e. after "denn")
- Know the meanings of all four words you write for each question: in class, you will ask your classmates these questions, and they may ask you what the words you chose mean
- The reason why the fourth word doesn't fit can be logical, as in the above example, but can also be things like "denn X ist kein Verb" [the other three are verbs, but X is not] or "denn X ist ein langes Wort" [the other three are short], or even something like "denn X beginnt nicht mit 'A'." It can also be subjective, like "denn ich bin nicht verheiratet" if your words were *klug*, *verheiratet*, *ledig*, and *sportlich*, or like "denn ich tanze nicht gern" if the other words were things you like to do.
- It's OK if you have just three options instead of four for one or two questions - but then there needs to be a good, logical connection between the two words that fit together.
