The objectives of the training

- ❖ To develop the skills and knowledge of the academics in the field of early childhood education and care, and to entitle them to be trainers for the Vocational Diploma.

(How can the participants approach and deliver the Vocational Diploma to the prospective teachers?, the diploma includes 12 courses in relevant to Psychology in the Early Childhood, Child Growth and Nutrition, Socialization in the Early Childhood, Child Literature, Motor Education ,Music, Concept Development ,Introduction to Technology in Education, Child Rights and Citizenships and Field Training)

- ❖ To familiarize the supervisors of the kindergartens and nurseries from the Ministries of Education and Social Development with the best practices in evaluating, improving and developing programs offered to pre-schools children, in line with the local needs and in line with international trends and standards.
