

Florence High School 2024-25 Educational Awards

William Susman and Frances Susman Scholarship Award (up to \$32,000)

- One (1) scholarship – amount TBD up to \$8,000 (\$4,000/semester) – renewable for four (4) years
 - o Must attend a Colorado Institute of Higher Education full time (12.0 hrs) and
 - o Maintain a GPA $\geq$ 3.0

John T. Morris Scholarship Award (up to \$28,000)

- One (1) scholarship – amount TBD up to \$7,000 (\$3,500/semester) – renewable for four (4) years
 - o Must attend full time (12.0 hrs) and maintain a GPA $\geq$ 3.0

One Time John T. Morris Scholarship Awards

- Additional one-year (OT) scholarships awarded based upon application, interview and funds available

One Time John T. Morris Reapplication Scholarship Awards

- Possible continuation for prior OT recipients based on funds available and a GPA of $\geq$ 3.0
- Note: Prior One-Time (OT) Recipients need to submit information including:
 - A new application/essay, new letters of recommendation, current transcripts.

Sally Provenzano Scholarship Award (up to \$20,000)

- One (1) scholarship – amount TBD up to \$5,000 (\$2,500/semester) – renewable for four (4) years
 - o Must attend full time (12.0 hrs) and maintain a GPA $\geq$ 3.0

Susman Morris COSI Scholarship – Graduating Seniors only

- Four (4) to six (6) \$1000 scholarships with matching funds from Fremont County **COSI Grant
- One (1) 4-year \$1000 scholarship – must maintain 2.5 GPA for autorenewal
- Contact counseling office for details – specific EFC and Pell Grant Eligibility required)

**Requires an additional application

Farmers Market Scholarship

- One (1) \$1000 scholarship (Focus on agriculture, culinary arts, vocational studies) (non-renewable)

Alvin and Carol Riveria Scholarship

- One \$4,000 Scholarship paid out over 4 years (\$1000/year – auto renewable with 3.0 GPA)

Patch Family Scholarships (\$4,000+)

- Up to five (5) \$1000 4-yr renewable scholarships (\$500/semester)
- Emphasis on vocational careers – students must maintain 3.0 GPS for continuing awards.

Provenzano Family Scholarship

- One (1) \$1000 scholarship (non-renewable)

RMBT- Doug McClure Memorial Scholarship

- One (1) \$1000 scholarship (non-renewable)
- Must include Rocky Mountain Bank and Trust Authorization form to acknowledge that the student or Parent/guardian has an active account with Rocky Mountain Bank and Trust.

Maude Klepzig Memorial Scholarship Award

- One (1) \$250.00 scholarship (non-renewable)

RGCVMCCA – Royal Gorge Chapter of Vintage Car Club of America

- One (1) \$1000 scholarship (non-renewable)

Morrie and Laurie Aves Memorial Scholarship

- Two (2) \$500 scholarships (non-renewable) Emphasis on vocational careers
