SCENE 1

[INT. ROOM 56] [CLICK]

CHIP

Uh, right. So we're here to investigate uhhh... we're here to investigate... Sorry. What did you say your name was?

OLIVIA

Olivia Ambrose.

CHIP

Uh huh. And you're here to report what exactly?

OLIVIA

My brother. Jordan. He's been acting very strange lately.

NICKY

Strange how?

CALLIOPE

Before you go any further, I want to preface that we get a lot of people reporting strange things here. Is it strange of the teenage boy variety or strange of the supernatural variety?

OLIVIA

Well, he's been shutting himself in his room, and-

NICKY

Oh, so it's the teenage boy variety.

CALLIOPE

Yeah, definitely.

CHIP

Guys, can you two let her talk please?

CALLIOPE

Sorry, Chip.

CHIP

... Olivia, you were saying?

OLIVIA

Right. Jordan. They've been locking themself up in their room for

hours on end, much longer than they usually do. But he's not in there alone. He has... [Sigh.] He has a new boyfriend.

CHIP

And this is a problem because...?

OLIVIA

Oh, him having a boyfriend isn't the problem! I don't care who he spends his time with or who he loves, it's just... his boyfriend... he isn't human. I... I've never seen him. They won't even let me meet him, and it worries me. The reason I came to you all is because I don't know where else to go... Because the only thing Jordan's told me about him is that his name is 'Mothman.'

[SHORT SILENCE.]

CHIP

Mothman?

[CHORUS OF "MOTHMAN" FROM EVERYONE ELSE. YES, LITERALLY EVERYONE.]

SAM

Why didn't you lead with that?

NICKY

We'll go immediately.

[CLICK]

SCENE 2

[INT. OUTSIDE JORDAN'S ROOM]
[CLICK]

[THE MUFFLED SOUND OF SOMEONE PLAYING GUITAR AND SINGING FROM INSIDE JORDAN'S ROOM. YOU CAN'T QUITE MAKE OUT THE WORDS.]

SAM

So Mothman is just... though this door?

OLIVIA

Uh, yep.

FREDDIE

If we go through that door, we'll meet Mothman?

OLIVIA

That's what I said.

NICKY

What does one even say to Mothman? I'm probably his biggest fan. I don't even know what I'll say to him. Sam, what should I say?

SAM

[Sigh. Sarcastically:] I don't know, Nicky. "Hi, Mothman! I loved your work in the 60s! Can I have your autograph?"

NICKY

You are so mean to me.

EVAN

[Sigh.] Just open the door, Olivia.

[DOOR OPENS]

[JORDAN CONTINUES PLAYING HIS UKULELE AND SINGING. WE HEAR HIM SING "... AND HAVE NOTHING TO FEAR, CLOUDS CLEAR-" BUT HE STOPS SINGING AND PLAYING AS SOON AS HE NOTICES SPIS HAVE ENTERED THE ROOM]
[MOTH SOUNDS]

NICKY

Mr. Mothman Sir I'm a big fan of your work!

[MUSIC STOPS]
[MOTH SOUNDS INTENSIFY]

SHAWN

Excuse me?

JORDAN

Olivia, I told you to stay out of my room!

NICKY

You're not Mothman.

SHAWN

Ah, you're one of those.

JORDAN

[He groans.] Third time this week.

CALLIOPE

Olivia... when you said mothman. You meant...

OLIVIA

Well, how was I supposed to know? I've never met the guy! I didn't know he was... he was...

EVAN

A man made out of moths?

FREDDIE

So... Not-Mothman... who are you?

SHAWN

It's a common misconception, you know. I am not Mothman. But I am a mothed man. A man who has been mothed. My name's Shawn Manning. I've been mothed. It's very nice to meet you.

CHIP

I'd shake your hand but... is it really, a hand? It's made of moths.

Will I hurt the moths if I shake your hand?

SHAWN

Oh, no. They're fine. They're a lot stronger than your everyday moths.

CHIP

[Light laugh.] Yeah, I can tell. Strong grip you've got.

NICKY

So... you're a Mothed man?

SHAWN

Well, I suppose you'd call me a mothed boy. I'm only seventeen. But mothed man has the alliteration. That's why I like it.

JORDAN

No, you just like the chaos of people thinking you're Mothman.

SHAWN

[He laughs.] Maybe. But you love it.

JORDAN

No, I love you. I don't love people barging in and asking for Mothman's autograph.

SHAWN

Fair enough.

EVAN

Do you want us to leave? Give you some privacy? Since this was a false alarm and everything.

OLIVIA

It's not a false alarm. My brother is dating a boy made entirely of moths!

NICKY

I don't see a problem with that.

SHAWN

I wasn't always made of moths, you know.

FREDDIE

You weren't?

SHAWN

No. Not at all. Come on, stay a bit longer. I'll make you all a cup of tea and I'll tell you all about when I was mothed.

SAM

I would love that.

JORDAN

[Murmur:] I wouldn't.

FREDDIE

Is no one going to acknowledge the fact that he's dating a myriad of moths? Or is that just a thing now?

OLIVIA

[She lets out a sigh of relief:] Thank you!

NICKY

I don't judge you for being gay, Fred. You shouldn't judge Jordan for dating the mothed man.

FREDDIE

You don't judge me for being gay, because you're also gay.

NICKY

Details, details.

SHAWN

So, who's staying for tea?

CALLIOPE

I'm in.

EVAN

I suppose we could stay a little longer.

CHIP

Come on, Ev. Even you have to be curious about this!

EVAN

[Slightly offended]: What's that supposed to mean? Chip Romero, are you calling me boring?

CHIP

I mean, only if you don't stay to hear about the moths.

EVAN

Oh, I'm going to listen so intently to the mothed man's story that you'll look boring.

CHIP

You'll have to be listening very intently then.

EVAN

Just watch me.
