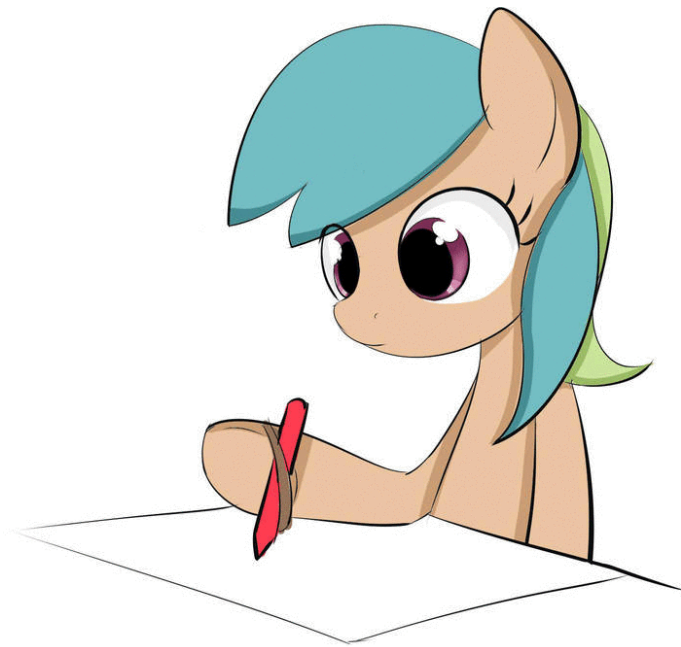

Post 1:

Request, draw, submit. Mark requests with ‘/r/’ in the name field or comment field, ‘/d/’ for deliveries, ‘/ic/’ for critiques. Please be patient with deliveries.

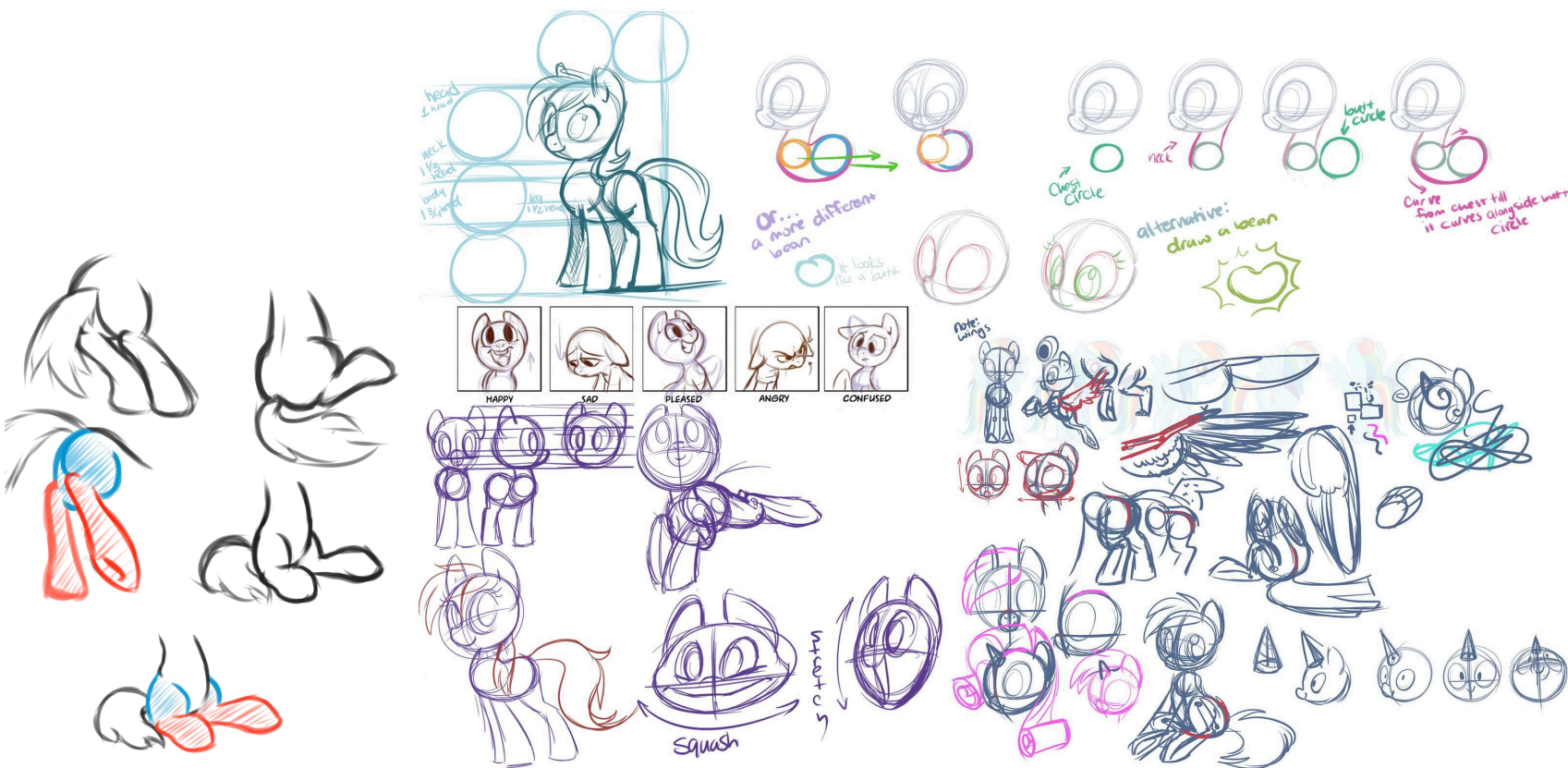

Guidelines

- **Requests and Critiques - Put /r/ or /ic/ in the subject field.**
**note on OC requests - Get approval from an OC thread before requesting. If an OC thread doesn't exist, you can either make one or post it in the thread. Be warned, OCs receive heavy criticism and shitposting.*
- **Bumping/Re-requesting - Your /r/ is in plain sight, you will never need to re-request.**
**note about multiple requests/special requests - If your /r/ has been completed but you want another variant of it, you can re-request it. If you want a drawfriend to draw your request, use the special request listed below under the About Commissions/Special Requests section.*
- **New threads should use the copypasta above to prevent deprecated information.**
- **To prevent duplicate draw threads, announce or claim that you are making a new thread as the old one approaches the bump limit.**
- **Other draw threads are not our business. Do not raid them.**
- **Do not shitpost. Shitposting includes, but is not limited to:**
 - Saying the threads have never fulfilled /r/'s.
 - Making a duplicate thread and claiming that the duplicate is NSFW (which is not true)
 - Requests to cancel an /r/ that is not your own.
 - Raiding the thread with a certain pony or porn.
 - Parody request spam - (e.g. goo pony /r/ spam, cars and pony /r/ spam)**note about Sombra & Wheaties /r/ - This is an in-thread joke but has occasionally caused shitposting. Please limit Sombra & Wheaties reposts (and all its variations) to one /r/ and one image per thread.*
- **Do not respond to shitposts. Ignore them, keep calm, and keep /r/ing.**
- **Do not link to streaming websites, as they are considered advertising and may result in ban, if you need to show you're streaming then try to get on the /mlp/ index of ponyhell, more details are down below.**
- **Do not post NSFW images, link to them if necessary. /mlp/ is a worksafe blue board, inappropriate images will result in deletion and ban**

GIMP stands for GNU Image Manipulation Program. It's an open source, freely distributed image processing program that's ideal for photo retouching/manipulation, and offers many of the same tools used in Photoshop. If you need one program to do it all, GIMP is definitely the best choice.

Paint.NET is a free image processing program running on Microsoft .NET Framework (included in the download, will autorun before install). It started as a more capable version of MS Paint and turned into a full featured program, sporting a UI similar to Photoshop.

SAI is a Japanese-made application for digital drawing and painting, and even though its support has been dropped, it's still one of the best drawing programs. Has drawing tablet support and there's even a quasi-vector layer button that allows for editable lineart. There's an English pack (full program, DRM free, linked above), so don't worry.

FireAlpaca is a free drawing program similar to SAI. Though it doesn't have the vector layer option, it borrows a lot of the UI and features the same drawing tablet support.

Made by the guys who created AutoCAD, Maya, and 3DS Max. Sketchbook Express has a very simplistic UI and drawing tablet support. As the name suggests, Express is a free version of a much more capable software suite, and thus only supports a few file types for saving, a 5 layer maximum, and lack of a lot of end-user control. Despite its shortcomings, it's a really nice app for drawing, especially if you have a tablet PC with active stylus support.

Like its desktop/laptop counterpart, Sketchbook Mobile also has an Express version (free). The Pro versions of this app are recommended for being far more capable (pressure sensitive capacitive stylus support, layers, brushes, blending modes, Photoshop document .psd export). Both versions offer a post to deviantART service.

**note about smartphone version - The smartphone variant is not recommended and is a separate purchase (you would have to buy it twice if you want it on both tablet and smartphone).*

Procreate is an amazing drawing/painting/fingerpainting app for the iPad with tons of options you'd see in a desktop drawing suite (pressure sensitive stylus support (limited), layers, blending modes, custom brushmaking, export to Dropbox, export as .psd, and time-lapse video export of the painting). Updated frequently, it has its own forum (hosted by the developers, with interaction between staff and community) where people can share work, report bugs, and learn how to draw. Also has its own [iBook](#) (free) for a reference manual. Definitely well worth the \$6.

Adobe has released their entire CS2 software suite for anyone to download. It's not optimized to run on current technology, and likely doesn't support all the features that current Adobe CS6 or CC programs do. However, it's still the old Creative Suite (After Effects, Audition, Illustrator, InDesign, Photoshop, Premiere Pro), and it's free (requires an Adobe ID login to download).
