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Superintendent's Report - Dr. Greg Williams- Business Advisory Council

Mr. Izor introduced Mrs. Nisbet and Mrs. Patton to share about their classrooms. Mrs. Nisbet spoke about teaching our future mathematicians. She shared how she has designed her classroom to facilitate sharing and discussing math ideas and math vocabulary. Mrs. Patton discussed creating student engagement in reading. She shared her use of EdPuzzles to help engage her students while reading The Hunger Games. She also shared that she used The Hunger Games as inspiration for student writing assignments after reading the book.

Mrs. Shepard highlighted college and career education regarding cyber security. High school students were able to attend a zoom meeting with a professional in cyber security and learn about the field and what attributes applicants would need to succeed in the field.
