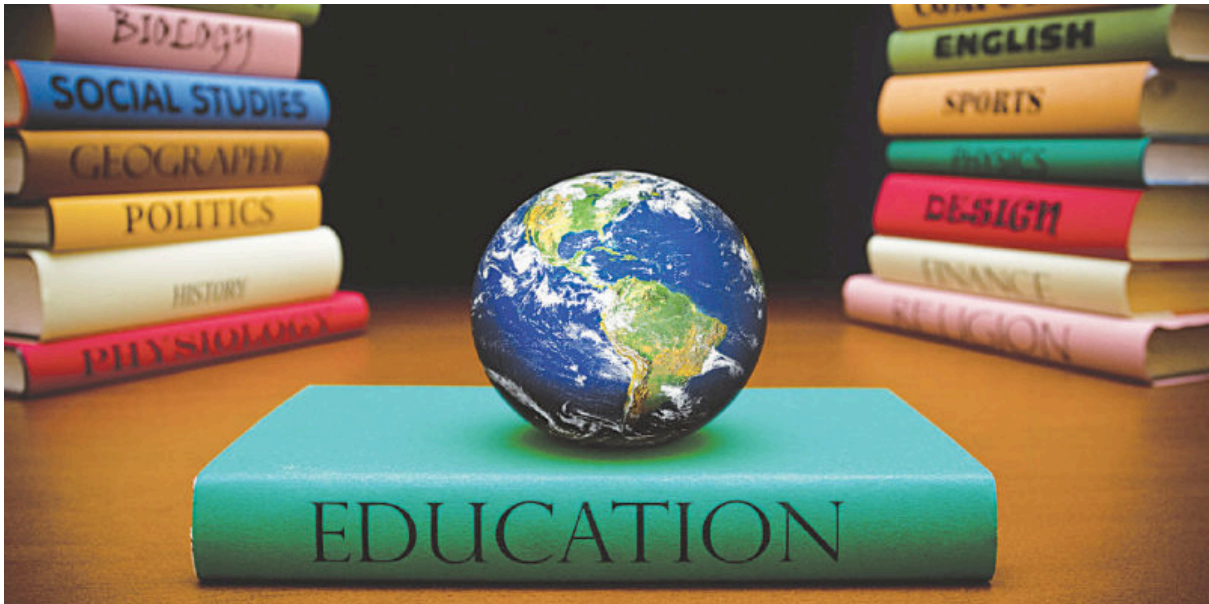


A working list of free resources that might be of use to those of us educating/entertaining from home.

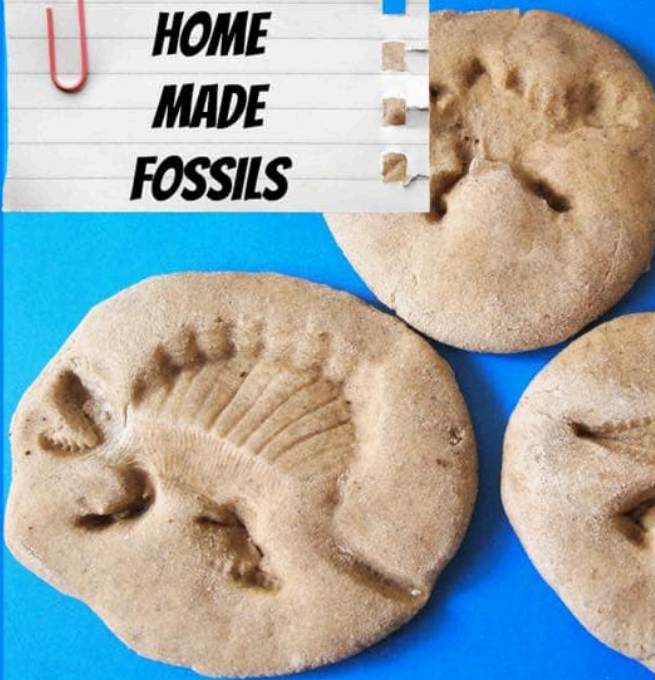
