GENERAL MEETING MINUTES:

Administrative Announcements (Hillary Duvall)

- **Welcome/ Announcements**
 - Ms. Duvall shared that she participated in a principal call for IPS re: testing data (EWEA/iRead/etc), and it was a real moment of pride for CFI 27 because our school is doing all of the right things to improve testing outcomes and are data are trending upward.
 - She highlighted this as an opportunity for us to share about all of the great strides



being made by our school and our great culture – encouraging everyone to share our story with families that might be ready to come to CFI 27 through social media, neighborhood platforms, word of mouth, etc.

- WIDA
 - Question came up about “WIDA” on testing calendar – Ms. Duvall shared that this is the test for English language learners to show how they’re progressing in language acquisition (includes listening, speaking, and reading comprehension components).

Treasurer's Report

- Currently have slightly under \$14,500 total funds with \$3300 delegated
- \$10,780 for general / \$500 of which donation for parent bash/ Christen may have also secured \$1000 donation for parent bash – she will confirm
- Have contractor working with to get updated basketball hoops and backboards that went through – so will need to pay invoice using part of family donation from summer
- Will need to use some funds to pay for shelving/refrigerator for Gleaner's Food Bank inventory (\$380 available)

Events

- **Food Bank:**
 - Moving forward with Gleaner's and having school as distribution site
 - Call to action coming for volunteers – will not be as heavy as a lift as previously thought because the pantry will be run through the cafeteria with a shelving unit



and distribution will be drop/in drive through style where families can select from menu and we'll pack bags to hand out

- Onboarding for the program is end of January and distribution will begin in February
- Agee called out that local high schoolers have to log a certain amount of community hours over the summer and this could be a good project match for them
- The Pacer's Group that helped with the giving tree offered to collaborate/donate more time
 - Could be a onetime thing where they set up shelving
 - Could potentially staff Gleaner's project once a month
 - Onboarding at end of Jan. first distribution in February

 - Will pull leftover items from past donations to help build out baskets
 - Will try to spread this out to provide multiple entry levels for donations
- Exploring potentially doing 1-3 raffle/door prizes at lower bid points to provide opportunity for everyone to participate
- Will create a full page flyer for Friday folders, jpeg for social media and digital promotion as well as principal update
- Babysitting:
 - Agee sent out call to high school students and have had 6 students signed up to babysit so far
 - This will be individual sitters at people's homes in lieu of kids night at school
 - Not able to organize that for this year because need administrator present to oversee
 - Will definitely look into do this next year
 - Will link the babysitter list to registration for event
