Giant metal dragon head unearthed! 8 foot tall = kind of giant for a dragon's head, like an ancient dragon.

Flat topped and comes to a point (like an anvil)

Mouth open and the horns go back and up

No blacksmithing tools other than anvil forge thing; no markings, runes, language or communication

Dorinda and Ego check out the metal to figure it out and its relation to forging with polvimithe (my album name)

Hrothulf pulls out Firehammer's Heart (i.e. Ruby Red) and contacts forge with it and scrapes some coating to see if it's a dragonhead dipped cone

Words on the sword glow red and H is convinced this is a real dragon skull (a kind of giant one) made into a forge anvil

Inquiring of Mrs. McPhoenie yields nothing as far as the origins of the forge...the forigins, if you will

9 words set in a 3 line Poem:

HNEGGHMAR HNEGGLIGÖ G'JAFFÎR LIF-THRASÎR. (Firehammer, the blazing heart, has given his life)

EIGNASTAFF IGNÛZHNØGG. (He will take it up again in the Flames of Rebirth) H'JØRDT MINNASKTÎR LIF-EIGNASTÄR. (This blade remembers his life with every life it takes)

Firehammer made weapons for Firefather (aka Glitn, Flame Daddy)

Barlow's Soul Sword to the skull yields a purply hue and then woosh, full on purple No one is quite sure how Vardumichlorians work and so not sure if it was forged and then made Vardumy or if it was forged with Varduminess.

Dorindego has decided the forge is not vardumilicious and that the metal is a lot like, though not identical with polivimithe. Reigning theory is that it is in fact, made of dragon bone. But basically no info about the metal; it's pretty basic.

Phoenix tries lifting the head out of the ground. Izar has doubts about this but no one knows of any other way to get underneath the forge (the outputs and hoses and stuff). But it's so awesome

Hrothulf ignites FHHeart (aka Ruby Red) and speaks the 9 word poem. The entire floor corkscrews downward spiraling the party deep underground. Whereupon, they discover an emptied armory save for 5 belts with Ourorboros shaped clasps. Feeding the dragon its tail (while not wearing any other armor, because..AT LEAST... magic reasons) and an ethereal suit of armor is donned (+4 AC free action once buckled to dismiss or re-engage, almost certainly other properties waiting to be discovered) thereby making Izar and Hiare look incredibly badass and also feel really badass

REMEMBER: armor does not stack but belts are open to interpretation
