The fourth subsection outlines the research objectives and contributions, explaining the purpose of the study and what it aims to achieve.

The final subsection describes the organization of the article, providing an overview of the structure to guide the reader through the paper. The introduction should

not only introduce the research topic but also define the problem, explain the gaps in the literature, and discuss the motivation for the study. It should clarify the aims and objectives of the research and highlight the significance and potential advantages of the work

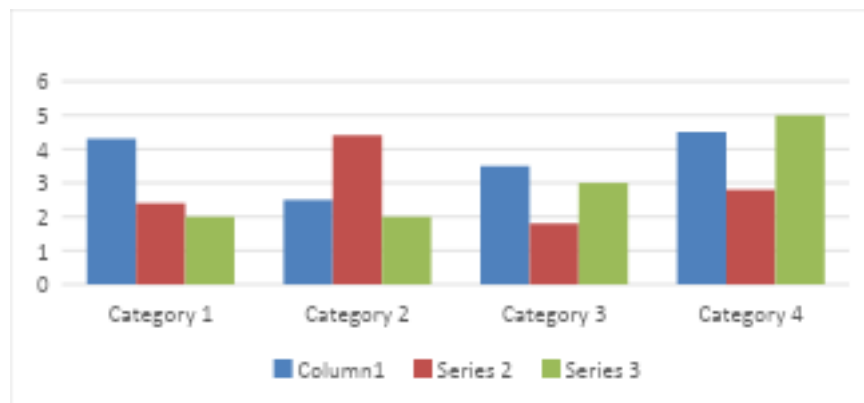
