



Mason Intermediate 2026 Reading Challenge

The **Mason Schools Foundation**, a non-profit organization, invites you to participate in our annual **2026 Reading Challenge Fundraiser on January 16th - January 30th**. Proceeds are used to continue funding Above and Beyond innovative projects and educational programs, which extend beyond the scope of what the district can provide.

Over the past 17 years, MSF has invested over \$1 million in grants across the district, including school supplies for students in need, instructional technology, flexible seating options, and educational experiences in and out of the classroom.

The Reading Challenge is the MSF's main fundraiser. Read as many books as possible **from Jan 16th - Jan 23rd** and raise money to earn raffle tickets for prizes.

- Level 1-Raise \$10 or more- Win a Menchie's Coupon, 1 Raffle ticket

How the Reading Challenge Works-

- ALL students will record their minutes read electronically on a Google Doc tracking sheet
- Students will have access to the doc at home and school to ensure all minutes are recorded for the previous day/s (Minutes will be recorded Tuesday, Jan. 20-Fri, Jan. 23).
- Minutes read Fri (Jan. 16)-Mon (Jan. 19) will be recorded the morning of Jan. 20 at school or can be recorded at home the previous night. For the rest of the week, students will record the minutes they read daily (either that same night or the next morning at school). Ensure you record ALL minutes read so they count towards MI's reading goal. The class that reads the most minutes daily will get a special surprise.
