

Roles & Responsibilities

General ed teacher roles and responsibilities

- Create modified and/or accommodated assignments and assessments based off of IEP
- Provide content-specific, grade-level instruction for all students
- Create data-based interventions to meet all learner needs
- Assess students on content-specific skills
- Progress monitor student interventions
- Communicate with associates on expectations in the room

Special ed teacher roles and responsibilities

- Manage IEPs
- Progress monitor students on their IEP goals
- Provide support with ideas for modifications and/or accommodations
- Collaborate with general education teachers to support modifications and/or accommodations
- Collaborate with general education teachers about student progress or need
- Inform general education teachers of student specific plans
 - Assist with strategies to support student academic or behavioral plan

Associate roles and responsibilities

- Listen and follow directions given by classroom teacher
- Provide follow-up instruction and reteaching of content already taught by teacher when directed
- Login in and help navigate with teachers if needed
- Prompt students when working on assignments given by teacher
- Use positive reinforcement
- Communicate with nurse when Faith needs medical attention
- Communicate and give subjective information/feedback about student progress to special education teacher
- Provide accommodations
- Assist individual students with IEPs and not with IEPs upon teacher direction

Non-examples of roles and responsibilities of associate

- Create work for student during class that was not directed by teacher
- Modify tests (reduce 4 choice option to 2 choice)
- Clerical work for the teacher
