### **Assignment Objectives**

- Students will learn Problem Solving Steps
- Students will apply Problem Solving Steps to solve a scenario

#### **Teacher Instructions**

- Share Problem Solving Steps with students:
  - Gather all information
  - o Identify the problem
  - Take time to brainstorm all possible solutions
  - Decide the best solution
- Read to students the below scenario, What would you do?
- Students brainstorm with a Paper tutor for #4 and document feedback

#### Ideas for Use

- Brainstorm #1-3 with a Paper Tutor
- Reflection Time: Students reflect on a past problem and review the Problem Solving steps
- Students create their own Problem Solving steps for future use and brainstorm the new created steps with a Paper tutor
