

Serenity Club Rules

1. Disrespectful, abusive or threatening language or action is prohibited.
 2. Vulgar and profane language easily audible to others is discouraged.
 3. Alcohol, drugs of abuse, and gambling are prohibited.
 4. Animals prohibited, unless documented as service providers.
 5. All items classed as weapons are prohibited.
 6. Children must be escorted by a responsible adult at all times.
 7. Loitering and panhandling are prohibited.
 8. Anti-social behavior (e.g. ridicule, belittling, unwanted personal advances or contact) is prohibited.
 9. Shoes and shirts are required at all times.
 10. During group meetings, all persons NOT on club duty or meeting in the one-on-one meeting rooms should attend the group meeting.
 11. Each person and group is responsible for cleaning areas used.
 12. If no club member with a pin keycode is present in club, the club must be emptied and locked by the last person present with a keycode.
- Any club Director or Officer may require anyone they deem disruptive to leave the premises, which include the club rooms and parking lot.
 - Serious violations may result in a 911 call to police by a responsible club member.
 - Witnesses are encouraged to report rules violations or incidents to board directors/officers, rather than intervening directly.
 - These rules in no way authorize physical interventions, except in cases covered by applicable laws and regulations.
