Google Docs is a powerful digital productivity tool offered as part of G Suite. Google Docs provides users with all the tools they need to create engaging digital products to support teaching and learning inside and outside the classroom. This class will look at tips and tricks like colors, fonts, hyperlinks, and headings to make your documents more engaging.
