Athlete Conduct – All athletes are reminded that you are ambassadors of your school and the Saskatoon Secondary School Athletic Directorate (SSSAD) and expectations for all athletes are that you are polite and respectful to all volunteers, officials, and competitors at the provincial competition. Drug, alcohol and tobacco use are strictly prohibited on any SSSAD sanctioned trip. Any athlete involved in such activity will be returned home at their own expense. Curfew times will be established and enforced by the school coaching staff.
