

Chromebook Touchpad Tips

Chromebooks with a touchpad only have 5 methods that you should definitely know of.



Move the Pointer:

Move your finger around on the touchpad to act as your mouse.



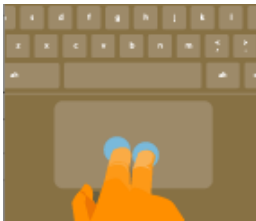
Click:

Either push down once or lightly tap the touchpad to perform a left mouse click.



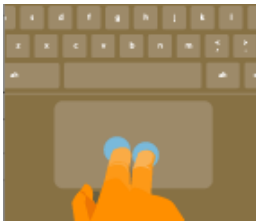
Right-Click:

Use 2 fingers and touch the touchpad.



Scroll:

Put 2 fingers on the touchpad and move them up and down for vertical scrolling and left or right for horizontal scrolling.



Swipe:

To go back or forward through tabs in Chrome, use 2 fingers and swipe left or right.



Drag and Drop:

Click and hold down on an item you want to move and with your other finger move the item. Release both fingers from the touchpad when you want to drop.
