

# HOW TO APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID for ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027

### □ COMPLETE THE 26-27 FAFSA:REQUIRED BY ALL US COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES

- Research priority deadline for each school on the college's admissions/financial aid page of their website; apply EARLY to BEAT the college's priority deadline
- Create FSA ID -student and parent(contributor) prior to completing FAFSA: <a href="https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/create-account/launch">https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/create-account/launch</a>

- Research priority filing deadline for each college on school's admissions/financial aid website

- Add each college requiring the CSS Profile to the form and the information will be sent to each school's financial aid office

- Use search engines to identify outside scholarships you may apply for: Fastweb, Scholly, Bold.org
- Check your email for announcements regarding the Arlington Community Scholarship Application and other local scholarships which will be available in the winter
