At the moment, here's my recommendations for reading if you're looking for some:

- 1. The reluctant fundamentalist | *Mohsin Hamid* (Counties/ culture)**
It juggles between Pakistan and the states. A deeply authentic story of ambition, love and the American dream.
- 2. God of small things | *Arundhati Roy* (Culture-child's view)**
Set in Kerala, it's India unadulterated, gives an insight into the fragile world of children. It's heartbreakingly tragic and uniquely beautiful. Read this if you want to try something different. Warning- it deals with heavier things like sexual assault and violent casteism
- 3. Anxious people | *Friedrick Backman* (light read)**
It's so funny I actually laughed out loud. A heartwarming tale of what makes us human. I think you'd like this!
- 4. The Book Thief | *Markus Zusak* (countries)**
Set during WW2, it's a brutal account of how hope hides in the crevices of a crisis. Fun fact: It's written from the perspective of death, it's literally death talking to you!

If you don't want to commit to an entire novel, here's some short story collections

- 1. Interpretation of Maladies | *Jhumpa Lahiri* (slice of life)**
It juggles Indian and American identities in a very gentle subtle manner.
- 2. Suddenly, a knock at the door | *Etgar Keret***
It's hands down one of the best short story collection I've read. Hilarious and truly excellent writing. Thoda atrangi
