 - 49036 active tags (unique checkers by GC code) up from 48516 (+520)

Challenge cache guidlines - Section 2.12

Challenge Cache Moratorium?

A 1 year halt on all challenge cache publishing gave GCHQ time to rework the rules and guidelines for challenge caches. Post-moratorium challenge caches abide by different restrictions than pre-moratorium challenge caches, which have been 'grandfathered' as is.

Moratorium started: April, 2015 Moratorium ended: May 25, 2016
