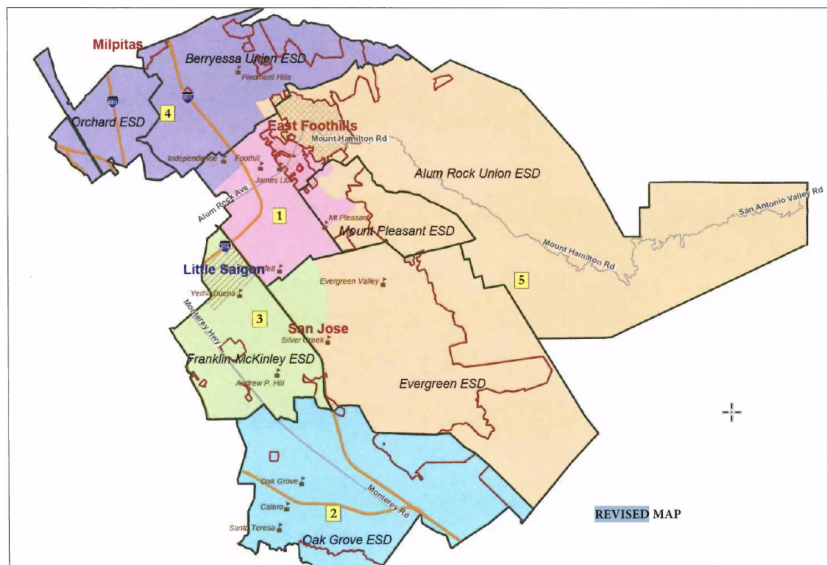
CALL TO ORDER: 4:05pm

1. **Introductions** - All participants introduced themselves.
2. **Approval of October minutes** - minutes passes unanimously
3. Elections of trustees: **District Election System Change Overview**
 - Board received demand letter in February from Malibu law firm
 - Alleged racially polarized voting in at-large trustee elections
 - District chose transition over litigation risk (potential millions in legal fees)
 - Public process April-September: 5-6 hearings, Saturday workshops, 26-27 public-submitted maps
 - Board adopted new 5-district map on October 3rd
 - District 1: Alum Rock area (pink)
 - District 2: Oak Grove area (south)
 - District 3: Little Saigon Seven Trees area (center-west)

- District 4: Berries Orchard area (north)
- District 5: East Hills/East Foothills area (east)

Election Sequencing and Waiver Request

- Current board member distribution by new districts:
 - Districts 1 & 2: No current board members
 - District 3: Two current board members
 - District 4: One current board member
 - District 5: Two current board members
- 2026 election sequence: Districts 1, 2, and 4
- 2028 election sequence: Districts 3 and 5
- Waiver needed for District 1 to serve 2-year term (2026-2028) then align with presidential cycles



4. Goal 4 Behavior Responses: Safety Plan Goals and Alignment

- Two main goals align with SIPSA #4 and LCAP:
 - Ensure healthy school environment prioritizing student safety
 - Decrease suspensions through alternative behavioral corrections
- Target: 1% overall suspension decrease over next three years
- Data shows steady decline in unique suspensions (2022-present)
 - **Current Safety Strategies and Support Systems**
 - School-wide lessons and grade-level presentations for social awareness
 - Student improvement luncheons acknowledging behavior/attendance/grade improvements
 - Mental health groups: anxiety, grief, tobacco/drug awareness, harm reduction
 - Weekly care team meetings with counselors, psychologists, social workers
 - Community-based organizations (City Peace Projects) providing on-campus support
 - Restorative practices including Saturday school, community service, mediations
 - **Communication and Process Improvements**
 - Staff feedback on difficulty reaching student supervisors during emergencies
 - Suggestion for family education sessions on progressive discipline vs. punitive responses
 - Need for enhanced social media awareness education for students

- Campus safety team receiving new radios before Thanksgiving

5. Student Updates: ASB Events and Activities

- Homecoming rally showcased all fall sports with alumni participation
- Halloween/Non-Fire rally with costume contest and class competitions
- Upcoming events:
 - Powder Puff week (girls football, boys cheerleading)
 - Winter Fest talent show: December 6th, two shows (4pm and 6:45pm) in Raider Hall
 - Canned food drive: November 17th - December 15th
 - Blood drive: November 21st with Stanford Blood Center

6. ELAC and ELL Program Updates

- English Language Learner Advisory Committee established for schools with 21+ ELL students
- Elevation platform training completion: 87% rate (above district average)
- Monitoring forms for ELL and reclassified students:
 - ELL on-level: 100% completion
 - ELL not on-level (D/F grades): 67% completion
 - Reclassified on-level: 100% completion
 - Reclassified not on-level: 71% completion
