Sensory Friendly Trick or Treat October 25th from 5-7pm @ Cresthill Middle School


### **IMPORTANT DATES**

ALL students do need a planner as we use this for multiple things but most importantly a family communication log. Your students should be coming home with their planners each day. In these planners, you will see what work they have written that must be completed or you will see daily notes from the adults that work with them throughout the day. I can supply students with all other materials if needed. Your students each should be coming home with a folder in their backpacks labeled **"Take-Home Folder"**. In this folder you will find unfinished work that they may need to complete or papers that need to be signed. Help your students get in the habit of pulling this out each day after school.

During ELT, we give our students a **snack break**. If you haven't already done so, please send your student to school with daily snacks or a bigger supply to store in our cabinets.
