THE INTRODUCTION

The introduction includes several points, namely: (1) Background, providing important information on the researched topic based on supporting data or facts. (2) Research problems, gaps, discrepancies, irregularities, and unanswered complaints which require in-depth investigation, as well as comparisons with previous research. (3) The purpose of the research expresses the researcher's desire in getting answers on the research problem.

LITERATURE REVIEW

includes theories relevant to the research topic being researched, theoretical framework (if any), and research hypotheses (if any).

METHODOLOGY

The research method is explained briefly, clearly, and concisely, covering key points such as: research approach, population and sample, data sources, operational definitions (if any), and data analysis techniques.

RESULT AND DISCUSSION

This section describes the research results based on the research objectives that have been set in the introduction section , the hypothesis (if any) in the literature review section as well as research methods that have been determined in the methodology section. This section also explains the importance of research findings based on the research problem, as well as a comparison on the findings to the previous research.

The title of the Sub Heading is written in italic style in both uppercase and lowercase letters.

This section describes briefly, concisely, and clearly on the conclusions obtained based on the research results. The conclusion is not a repetition of the results and discussions that have been described in the previous section, but rather describes the implications of the findings, research weaknesses, current research contributions, and recommendations for further research.

References used is the APA (American Psychological Association) format, using reference software such as Mendeley, Zotero, Endnote, and Grammarly. References must consist of 80% of journal articles and published at least 10 years ago. Below are some examples of how it should be written:
