

# Newline - Save and Transfer a Screenshot

*There are a lot of ways to take screenshots and annotate them on the Newline Board, but here is the way using the built-in software to the board itself.*

1. Open the application you want to take a screenshot of and annotate upon.
2. Press the annotate button on the toolbar of the Newline board.



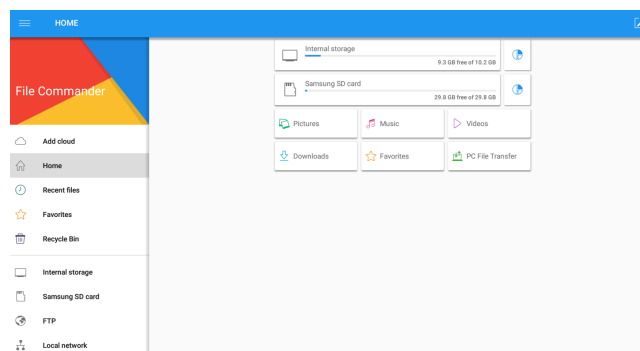
3. Annotate as you desire using the annotation tools at the bottom of the screen.



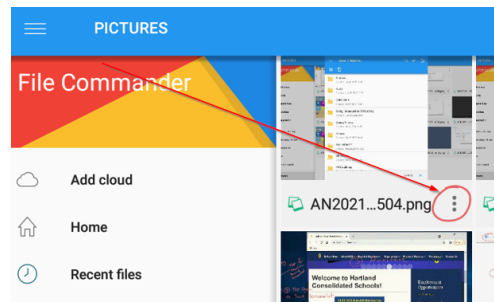
4. Press the annotate button again to save the screenshot.



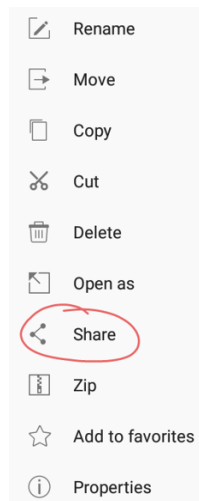
5. Browse to the File Viewer on the Newline Board.



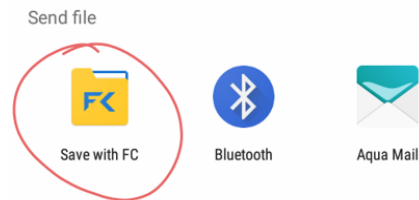
6. Insert your USB Drive into one of the boards USB ports.
7. In File Viewer, browse to the “Pictures” folder.
8. Find the screenshot annotation you are looking for.
9. Tap the “snowman” menu to the lower right of the image you want to save.



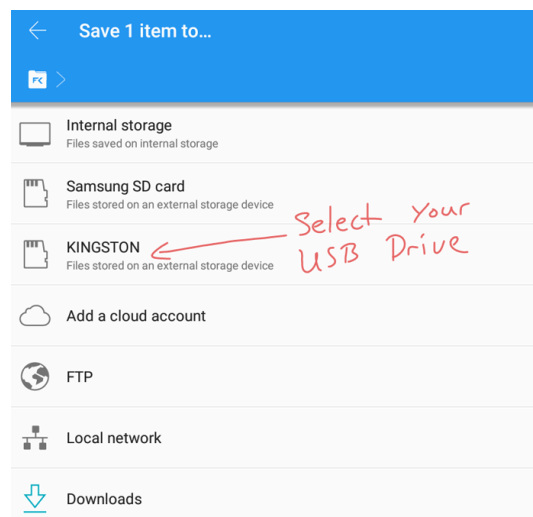
10. Select “Share” from the pop-up menu.



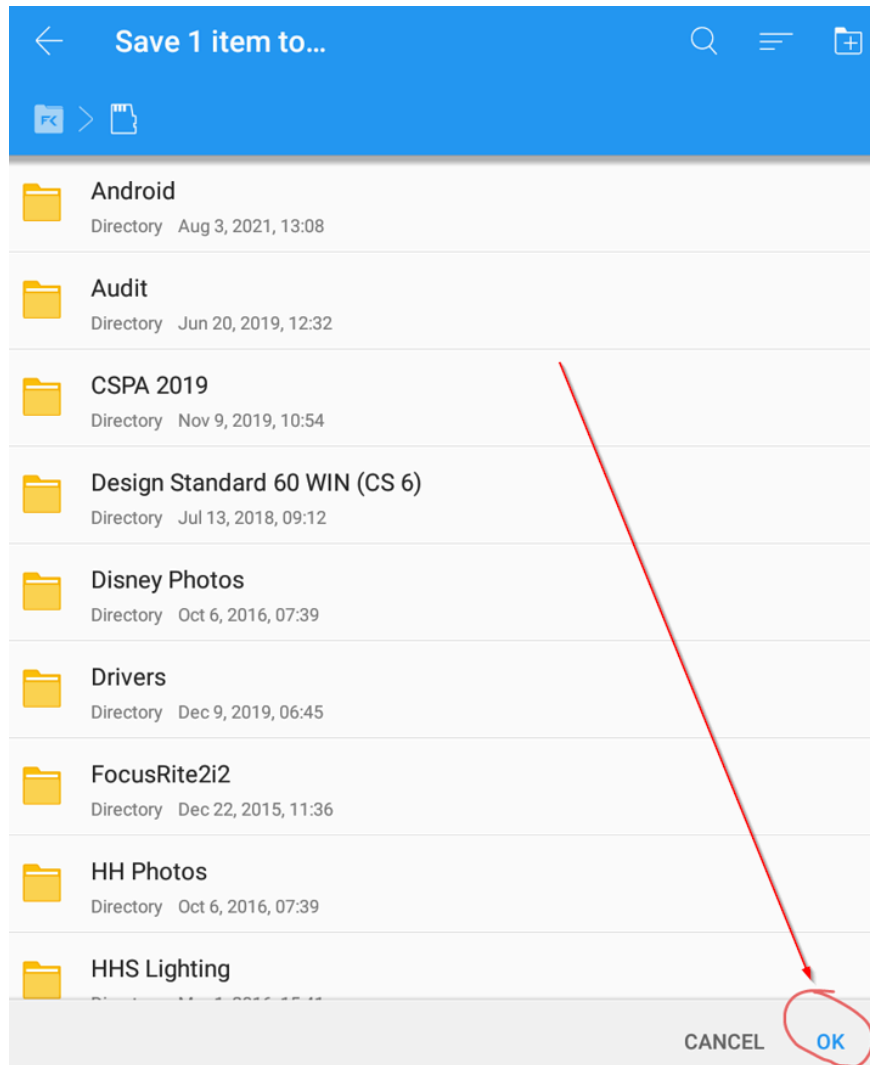
11. Choose the FC button.



12. Browse to your Thumb Drive.



13. Press "OK".



14. Now you can take your thumbdrive out of the Newline Board and transfer the screenshots to your computer and do with them what you wish.
