

24/7 Dance Fusion Collective Costs 2026-2027

PAYMENT PLAN

There is an initial \$400 Commitment Deposit due upon acceptance (\$300/each for siblings). It is non-refundable and will go towards your total balance due for the season upon acceptance. DFC families will then make 10 total monthly Installment payments. The installment payments are charged on the 15th of each month (July-April). Delinquent payments will result in a late fee and possible disqualification from the program. All estimated costs for the year (rehearsals, choreography, costumes, workshops, competitions, productions) will be totaled and split into 10 even payments. Additional expenses/balances would be billed at a later date. Anticipated monthly installments are estimated below, based on 1 child in company (sibling rehearsal discount not noted). Studio classes, rehearsal attire, shoes/tights/etc are NOT included in this amount. Current figures based on 2025-2026 dance year. Subject to change.

COST BREAKDOWN:

REHEARSAL FEES

Rehearsal fees go towards studio space, facility maintenance, instructor compensation, etc. Also included in this is the Choreography for a Production. This fee is set at \$60/payment for each student (\$600/year). Sibling Discount: The fee is set at \$500/year for each student (2 siblings in Collective), and \$400/year for each student (3 siblings).

CHOREOGRAPHY FEES

Choreography is what makes up a dance. Fees are based on level, and go towards compensating the choreographers for their time, talent, and travel. This season we are continuing to try to make additional choreography more affordable and are using a sliding price scale.

CLASS REQUIREMENTS

-Jazz/Contemporary groups (Seniors/Teens) – 4-6* total classes depending upon level:
1-2* Ballet, Jazz, Contemporary, TLC, choice* of Hip Hop/Tap/Acro/Musical Theater

-Jazz/Contemporary groups (Juniors) – 4-5* total classes depending upon level:
Ballet, Tap, Jazz, Contemporary, TLC*

-Mini company – 3 classes: 1 Ballet & 1 Jazz & 1 Tap

-Hip Hop groups – 2 total classes: 1 Hip Hop class + 1 Jazz

-Tap groups – 2 total classes: 1 Tap class + 1 Jazz

-Musical Theater groups – 2 total classes: 1 Vocal class + 1 Jazz

*****Studio Technique class costs are NOT included in the Monthly \$ Installment listed at the top*****

COSTUMES

Costume payments (already included in monthly installment) are the sole responsibility of the parent/guardian. You will need 1 costume for each dance in which you are cast, plus any Collective Productions. The average costume costs \$100 for Mini/Junior levels and \$125 for Teen/Senior levels.

COMPETITION

All dances are planned to compete twice per season (some may compete 3 times). Estimate \$60-80 per group dance for each competition we attend (\$60 per group dance at a straight competition and \$80 per group dance at a convention competition such as Revel, DMI, or Monsters). Built into the installment plan is \$60-80 for each dance & \$70 per Production (for 2 competitions each). Optional solos, duets, and trios are additional.

WORKSHOPS

All Dance Fusion Collective members Junior level and up will be required to attend at least one workshop/convention outside of 24/7 this season, and the Summer eXtreme 14 intensive at 24/7 Dance Studio. DFC members may be required, or have the option, to attend additional conventions. Mini Company dancers are not required to attend, but may opt to do so. Workshop Fees will be included in your monthly installment individual to each dancer's registration needs/desires. If you sign up for additional workshops/conventions, there will be additional fees, and individual accounts can be adjusted to include additional required or optional workshops/conventions.

FALL SHOW

All Dance Fusion Collective members *may* participate in a Fall Show, if we have one that season. All company members will pay a Show fee (already included above), which covers choreography, theater rental, rehearsals, show staff, etc. Does not count towards # of dances. We ARE planning on a Fall Show for the 2026-2027 season.

REHEARSAL ATTIRE

Black leotard (style is your choice) + Caramel/Mocha tights and/or Black spandex shorts (your choice)
Male dancers: Please wear form fitting all black dance attire
Appropriate footwear for all
Hair secured in a bun and/or ponytail
Tap and Hip Hop dancers may wear your own comfortable all black dance attire. Ponytails acceptable.

SHOE REQUIREMENTS

Dance Fusion Collective members may have to purchase any or all of the following shoes, depending on genres/choreography. **DO NOT PURCHASE until confirmation from your Director.**

- Jazz boot – Capezio #EJ2 or SoDanca #JZ45 (caramel/mocha, and/or black)
- Capezio caramel/mocha pedini #PP323
- Capezio Freeform jazz shoe #FF01 (caramel/mocha, and/or black)
- Pink/Black canvas split sole ballet shoe – So Danca SD16L
- Capezio pirouette I canvas lyrical shoe (nude)
- T-strap Character shoe w/2” heel – choose Capezio #700, or SoDanca CH56/CH57 (caramel/mocha/black)
- Tap: Jason Samuel Smith OR So Danca TA715/815 in black
- Hip Hop: TBD (we have been using Nike Air Force 1’s or lookalikes in all white)

Each student should have extra pairs of all shoes used in performance. Sometimes we ask dancers to purchase shoes specific to the costume for one particular piece.

24/7 SRC

All Collective members are required to join the SRC, which is our non-profit 501©3 company that aids in all of our fundraising. There is a \$100 membership fee. You can choose to complete the required volunteer hours (approximately 15-20 per family), or contribute \$400 towards the SRC. Most parents find that volunteering for our fundraising events is a great way to forge relationships with other parents and to help give great benefits to the children!
